Advanced Placement Required Summer Reading:

Grade 9: *A Separate Peace* by John Knowles

Grade 10: *My Name is Asher Lev* by Chaim Potok

Grade 11: *The Crucible* by Arthur Miller

Grade 12: *Wuthering Heights* by Emily Bronte

Although it may be beneficial, Pre-Advanced/Advanced Placement students are not required to purchase copies of the titles assigned. The Frisco Public Library has multiple copies of each book listed available for check out. Each high school campus also has a limited number of books that may be checked out during the summer for two weeks at a time.
