Dear Parent or Guardian,

In a rapidly growing school district such as Frisco ISD, it is very important that we work to make sure that students are attending school in the appropriate attendance zone, understanding that it can be confusing.

In order to accomplish this, we are requiring an annual proof of residence which must be provided by September 4, 2009, or 10 days after enrollment. Acceptable proof of residence is a copy of a current (current or previous month) utility bill (electric, gas, water) or a current lease (for 30 days until a utility bill is available). If you have recently purchased your home, a copy of the closing papers will suffice until a utility bill is available to reproduce (within 30 days). If you are living with a relative or friend in our zone, an affidavit must be completed, notarized and returned to the school office along with a current utility bill.

This is very important, so please make every effort to provide this documentation. Students who are unable to produce documentation to verify residency in our zone may not be able to attend our school and will be subject to withdrawal.
