

Region 10 Safe Schools Survey Results

Available to all 7th through 10th grade
students

4904 or 61% of eligible students
participated

Alcohol Related Responses

- 19.4% / 953 Reported using during the past 12 months
 - 44.6% / 425 – 1 or 2
 - 32.0% / 306 – six+
- 17.2% / 843 consider alcohol use a major problem
- 21.7% / 1065 consider it a small problem
- 660 students reported first using alcohol ages 10 to 13
- 13.5% / 662 students reported seeing alcohol on campus

Drug Related Responses

- 8.6% / 422 Reported using marijuana or other drugs within the past 12 months
 - 32.5% / 137 - 1 or 2
 - 53.1% / 220 - 6+
- 22.3% / 1096 consider drug use a major problem
- 23.5% / 1115 consider it a small problem
- 14.2% / 744 consider drug selling a major problem
- 12.5% / 614 consider it a small problem
- 196 reported first using drugs ages 10-13
- Seen on campus:
 - 14.6% / 716 marijuana
 - 8.0% / 390 other drugs
 - 15.6% / 763 pills

Athletic Random Drug Testing Results

- Began in 2001-2002
- 5874 total tests
- 00.51% / 30 positive test results
 - 28 for marijuana
 - 2 for cocaine.

DAEP and JJAEP Drug Related Placements

- 42 total DAEP Placement
 - 36 for drug related reasons
 - 6 for alcohol
- KEYS
 - 1 alcohol
 - 4 drug
 - 2 inhalant, 1 marijuana, 1 prescription meds
- SOC
 - 5 alcohol
 - 32 drug related
 - 26 marijuana, 5 controlled substance, 1 prescription med
- DAEP
 - 5 for drug related offenses while assigned to DAEP

Off Campus Drug Related Arrest Notifications

- Under Article 15.27 (a) of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedures, law enforcement officials are required to notify school districts of any arrest of a student enrolled in that district.
- 34 notices were received for drug related reasons
 - 24 for possession of marijuana
 - 5 for possession of other substances
 - 5 for possession of drug related paraphenalia
