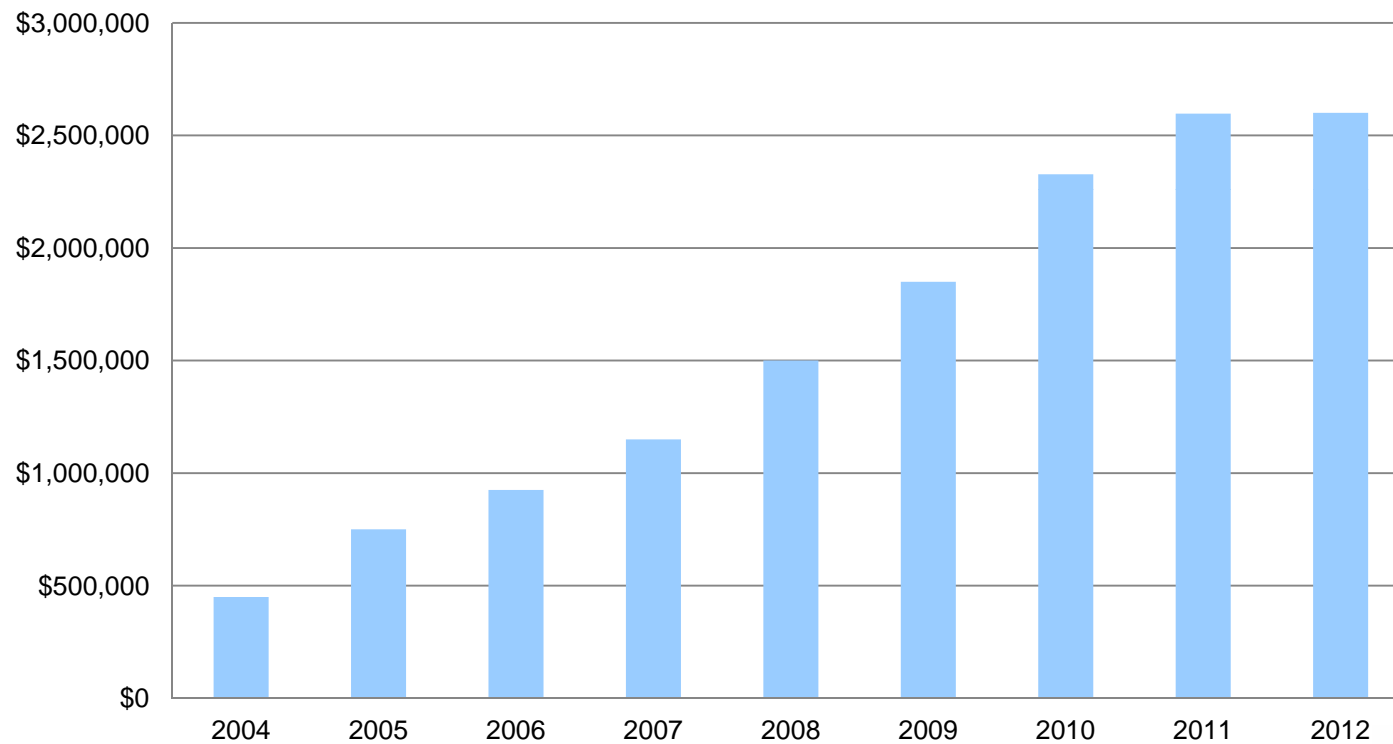

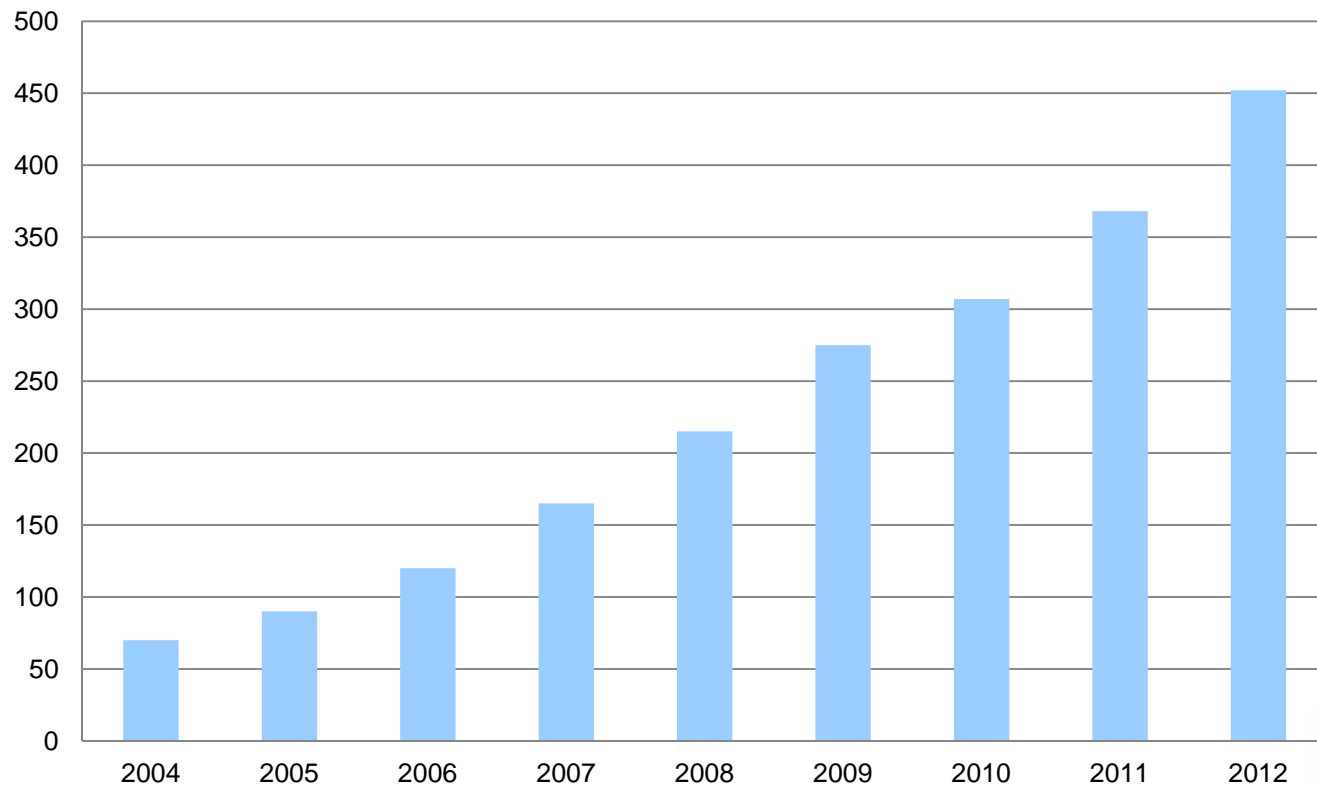

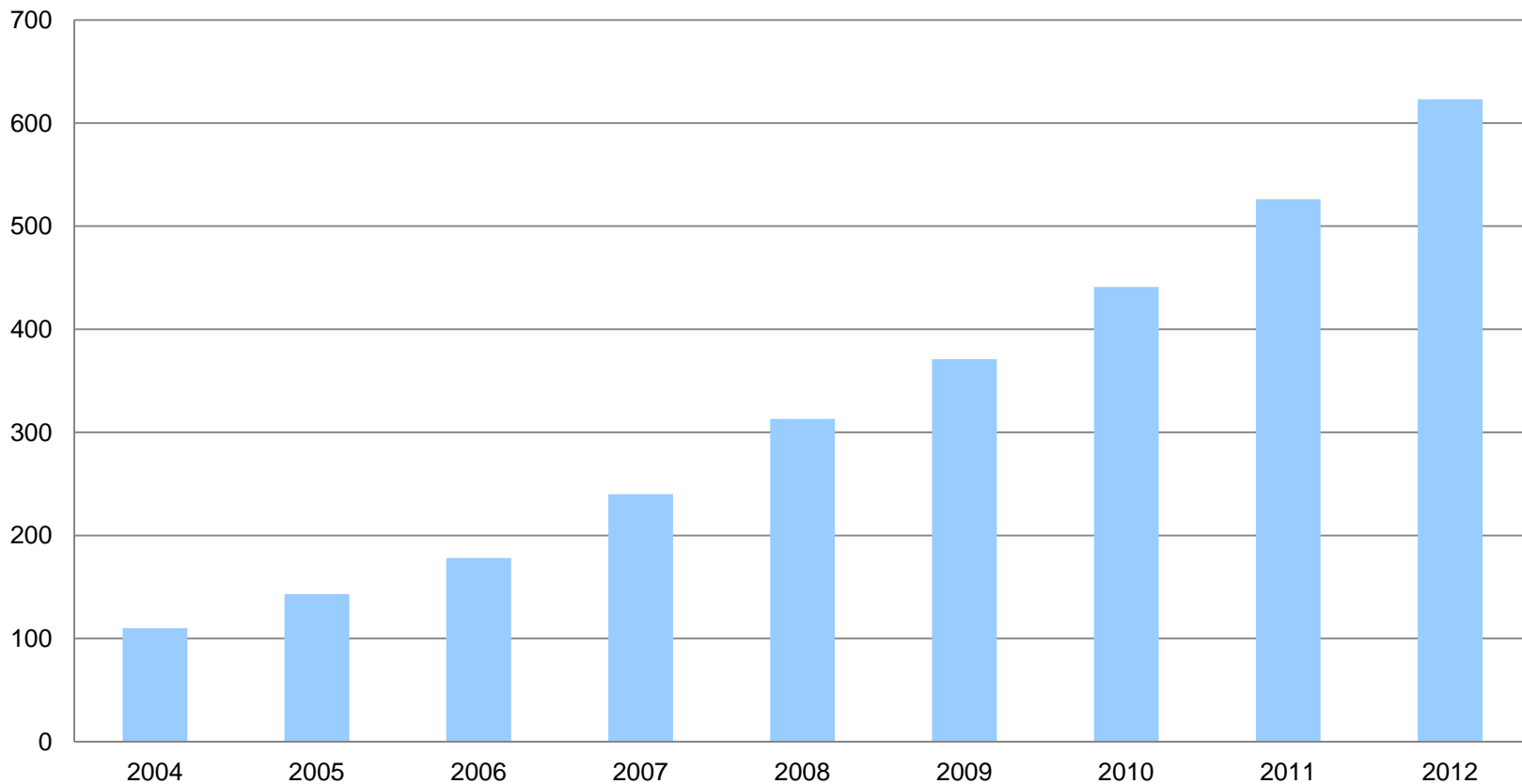
Number of Scholarship Recipients by Year

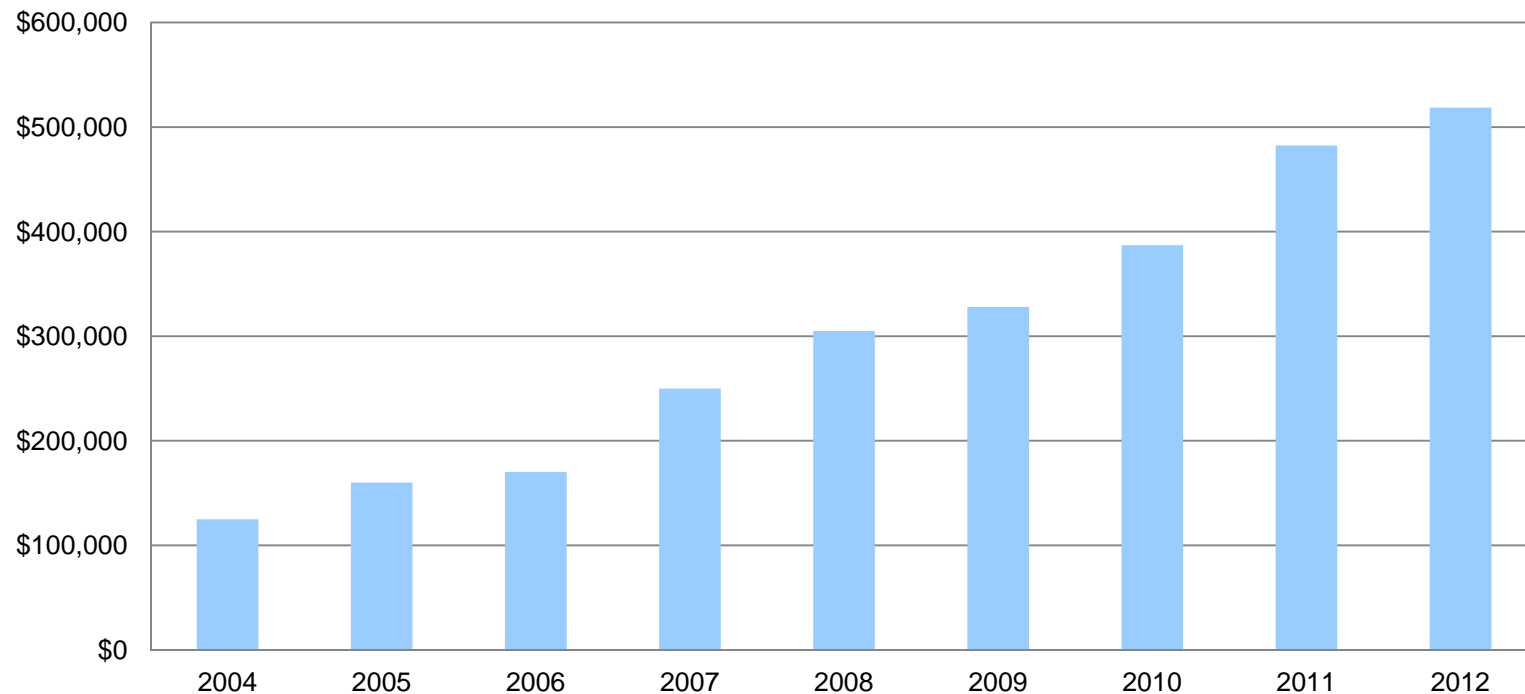
Number of Scholarship Awarded by Year

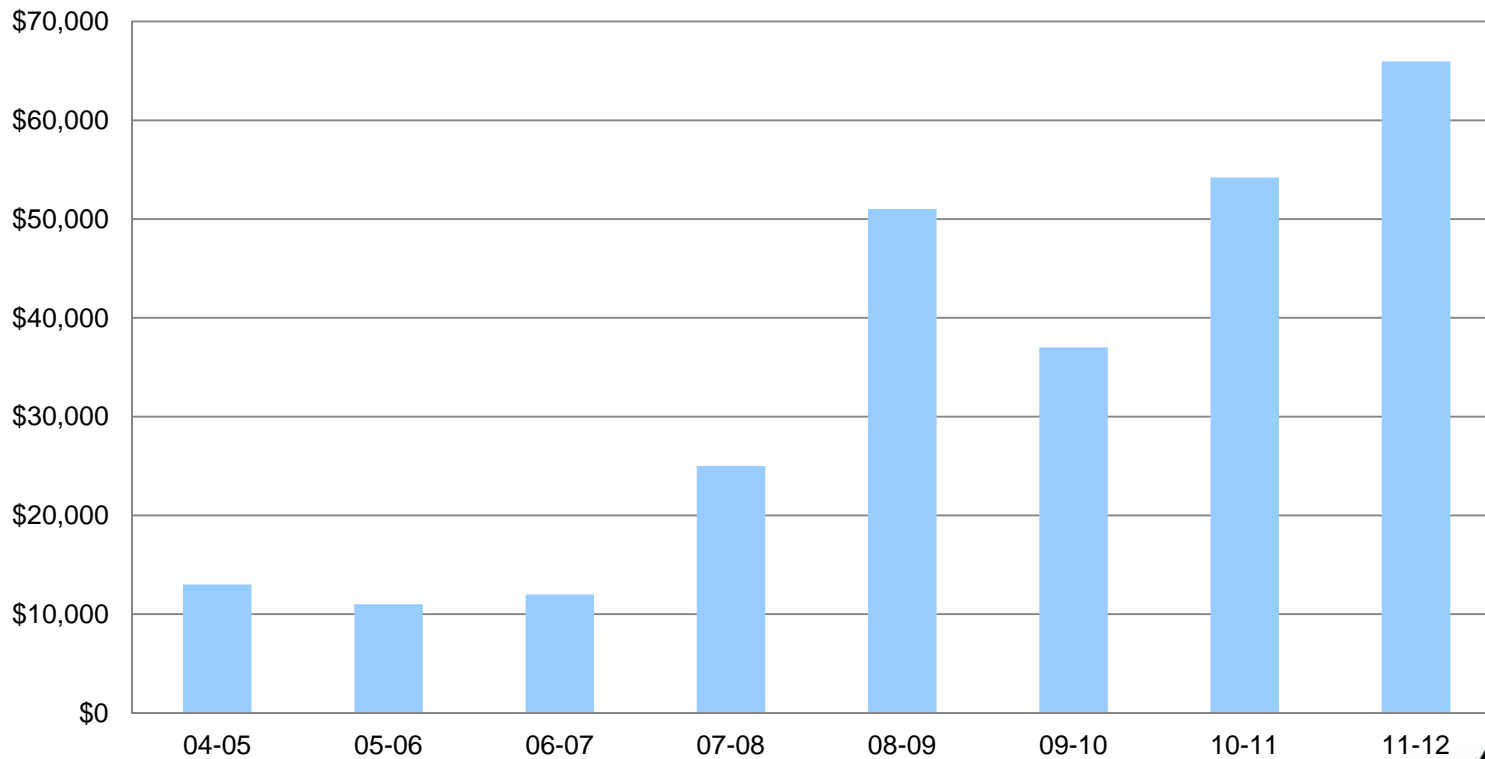
