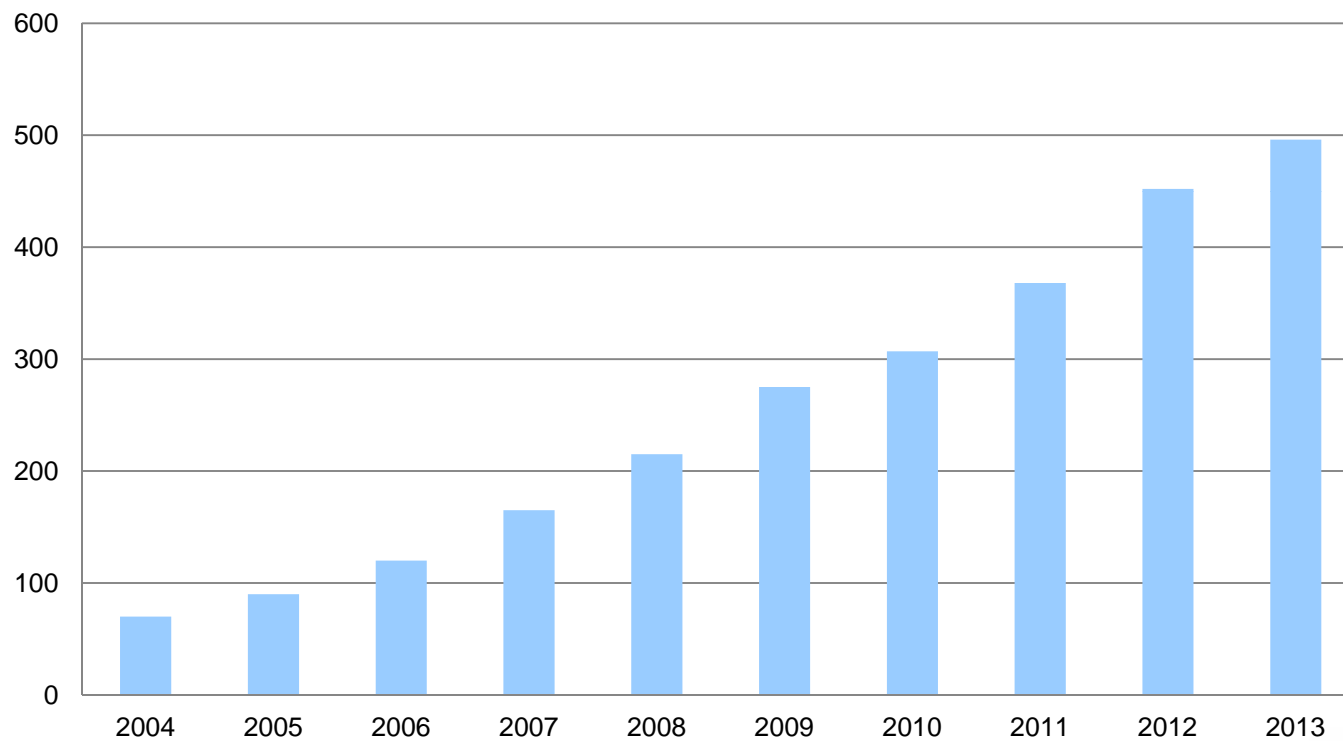

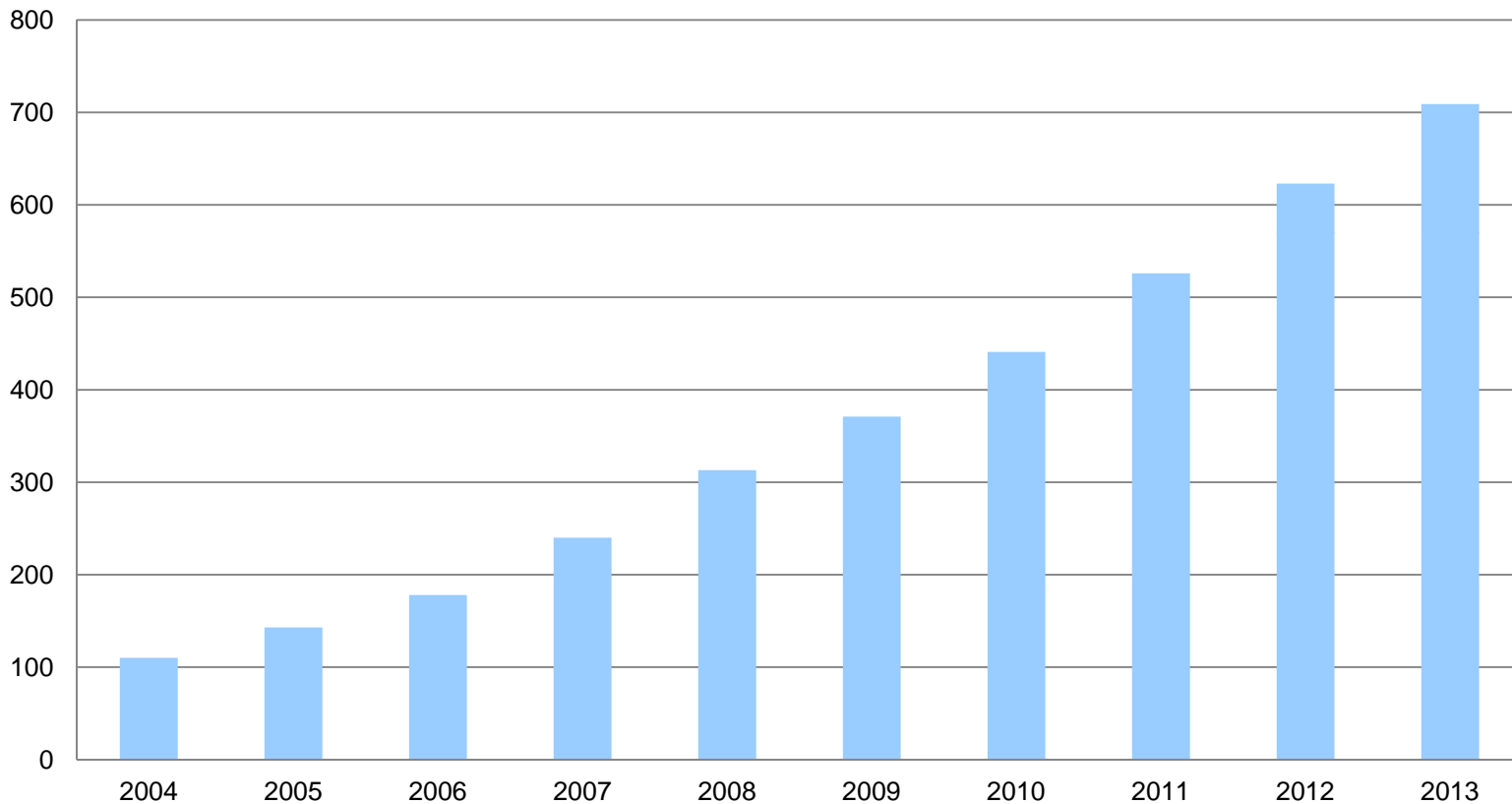
Number of Scholarship Recipients by Year

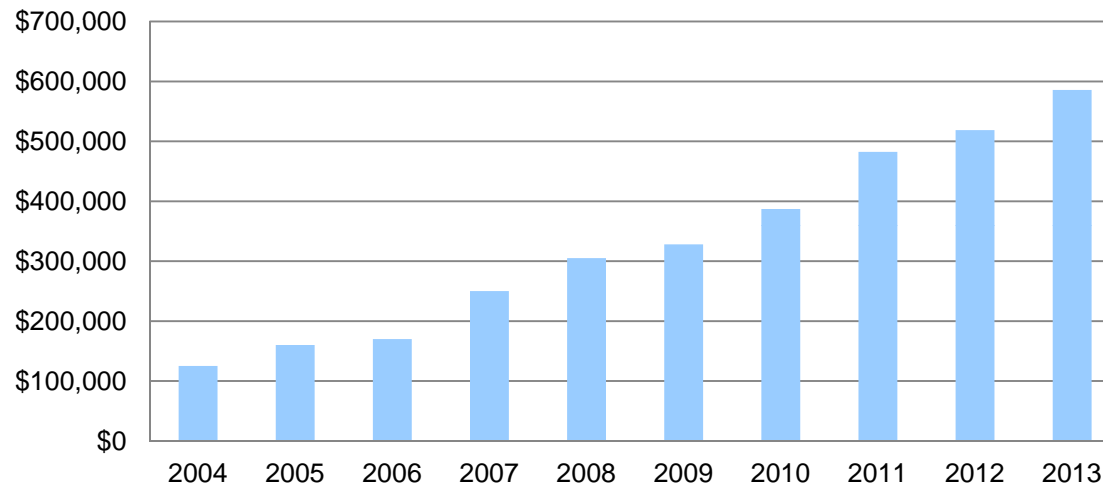

Scholarship Dollars Awarded by Year

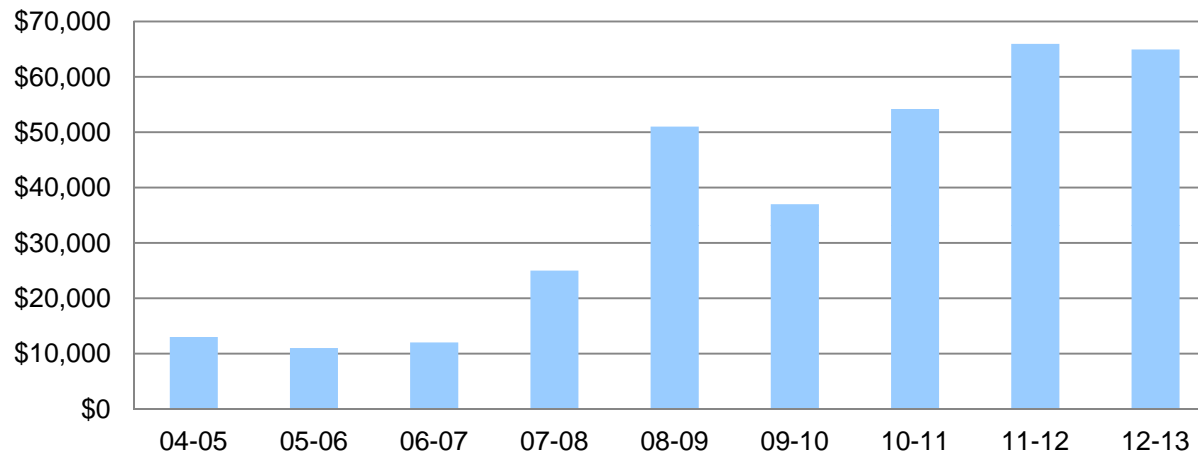


The Fisd Class of 2013 received more than 700 scholarships through FEF totaling over \$585,000.

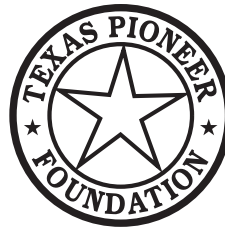

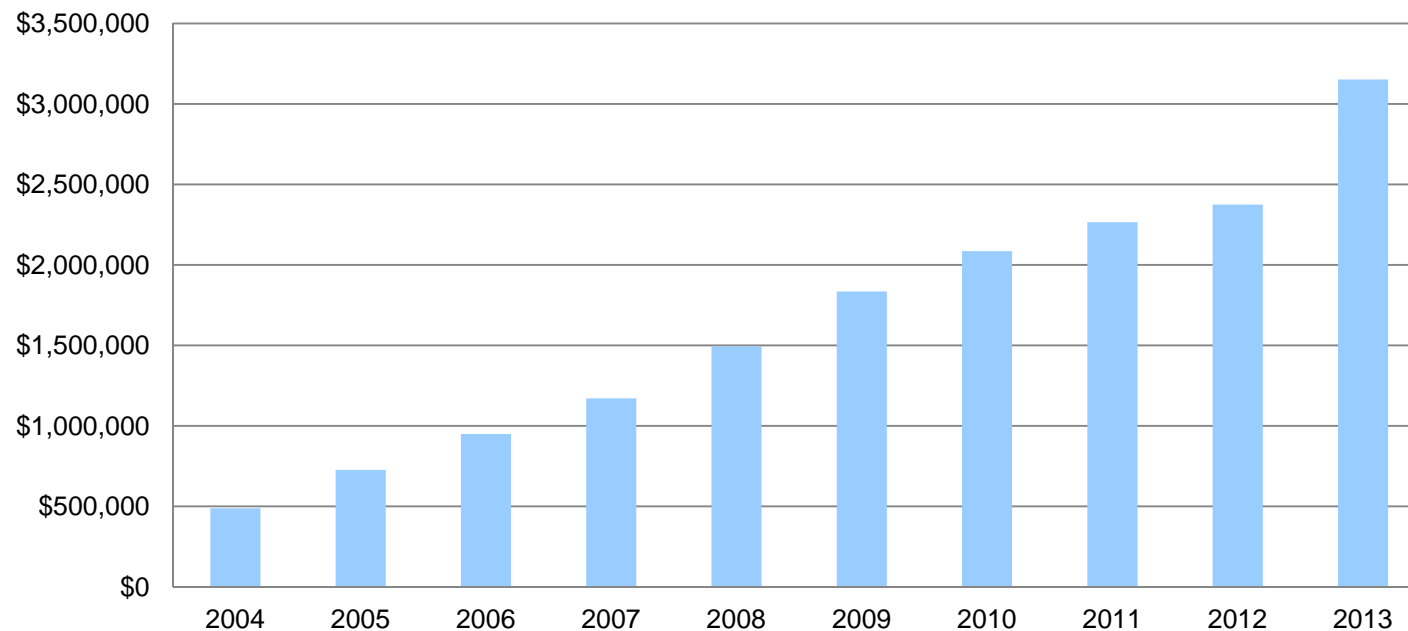
