May Election Comparison:

- Collin County—28 Early/44 Election Day
- Denton County—20 Early/43 Election Day
- Collin County has used as many as 129 polling sites on a National Election Day and has a strict early voting site ratio based on county commissioner precincts

May 2009 Election (Cancelled in 2010)	\$30,538.10
May 2011 Estimate With City Proposed Additions	\$47,445.17

(Approximately \$3,000 per Frisco early voting site and
\$1,200 per Frisco Election Day voting site)

FURTHER CONCERNS AND CONSIDERATIONS

- Walking distance and Department of Justice preclearance concerns with City Hall site vs. Staley Middle School site
- Traffic/parking/space restrictions and safety concerns with fire stations on Election Day
- No county buy in for this type of plan so there will be no real consistency as city desires
- Extreme cost escalations as we move toward build-out if city proposal is embraced
- Do dramatic increases in polling sites garner a real increase in voter turnout or is it more dependent on what or who is on the ballot?
