



Funding Issues

- Protect the promise of Additional State Aid for Tax Reduction (ASATR) until another funding source is put in place to ensure that FISD does not lose funding that helps to support our continual fast growth.
- Modify or eliminate the 50-Cent Debt Test.
- Restore funding for New Instructional Facilities Allotment (NIFA).
- Increase Existing Debt Allotment (EDA and Instructional Facilities Allotment (IFA).
- Funding to support HB5 Pathways including Career and Technology programs and additional counseling services needed to support those endorsements.
- Full-day prekindergarten.
- Continue funding for state mandated increase to Teacher Retirement System (TRS).

Oppose Vouchers/Restrict Charters

- Oppose all measures that would support any private program using public tax dollars.
- Hold Charters accountable to same state requirements. Certifications same as public schools. Equal opportunity to all students wanting to gain admission to a charter school.

Assessment and Accountability

- Accountability system to measure student growth and achievement.
- Reduce high stakes tests for grades 3-8.

Local Control

- Ability to set the school calendar.
- Flexibility for innovation and choices with public schools, ie CTE.
- Greater flexibility in setting tax rates.
