Centennial is accredited by the Texas Education Agency and has earned a rating of Exemplary. Out of the class of 2021, ninety-eight percent of the student body was college-bound. Sixty-four percent attended four-year schools, thirty-four percent attended two-year schools.

Grading System

For a student to earn credit for a course that is a full year in length the average of the two semester grades must equal a minimum of 70.

Grade points are awarded based upon the grade earned and the designation of the course as Regular, Dual Credit, Pre-AP/Advanced, or AP.

Centennial High School operates on an A/B day block schedule. Students attend 4 classes a day for 1.5 hours each.

Rank in Class

Per board policy, Frisco ISD does not rank students past the Top 10%. Students GPA reflects a cumulative GPA from all final grades earned in courses for high school credit with the exception of summer school, correspondence classes, and locally developed courses such as Study Skills, Office Aide, and Teacher Aide.
