Lebanon Trail High School has set a high standard of excellence, and has an enrollment of 2,097 students in grades 9-12. Lebanon Trail is accredited by the Texas Education Agency. Out of the class of 2025, ninety-four percent of the student body was college-bound (seventy-eight percent planned to attend four-year schools and sixteen percent planned to attend two-year schools.)

COMMUNITY

Frisco ISD is a community located approximately 30 miles north of Dallas, Texas. The district serves students in Frisco, Plano, McKinney, and Little Elm. Frisco ISD currently serves over 62,000 students at 77 campuses and is the largest district in Texas to earn an A in the 2024-25 TEA accountability rankings.

Grading System

For a student to earn credit for a course that is a full year in length the average of the two semester grades must equal a minimum of 70.

Grade points are awarded based upon the grade earned and the designation of the course as On-level, Dual Credit, Pre-AP/Advanced, or AP.

Rank in Class

Per board policy, Frisco ISD does not rank students past the Top 10%. Students GPA reflects a cumulative GPA from all final grades earned in courses for high school credit with the exception of exams for credit, and locally developed courses such as Study Skills, Office Aide, and Teacher Aide.
