Memorial High School has set a high standard of excellence, and has an enrollment of 1451 students in grades 9-12. Memorial is accredited by the Texas Education Agency. Out of the class of 2023, eighty-six percent of the student body was college-bound. Seventy percent attended four-year schools, sixteen percent attended two-year schools.

### COMMUNITY

Frisco ISD is community located approximately 30 miles north of Dallas, Texas. The district serves students in Frisco, Plano, McKinney, and Little Elm. Frisco ISD is one of the fastest growing districts in Texas serving over 65,000 students at 75 campuses.

### Grading System

For a student to earn credit for a course that is a full year in length the average of the two semester grades must equal a minimum of 70.

Grade points are awarded based upon the grade earned and the designation of the course as On-level, Dual Credit, Pre-AP/Advanced, or AP.

### Grade Distribution

The top ten percent of students had GPA's of 4.93 and above. The top twenty-five percent had GPAs of 4.694. The median GPA was 4.266.

### Daily Schedule

Memorial High School operates on an A/B day block schedule. Students attend 4 classes a day for 1.5 hours each.

### Rank in Class

Per board policy, Frisco ISD does not rank students past the Top 10%. Students GPA reflects a cumulative GPA from all final grades earned in courses for high school credit with the exception of summer school, correspondence classes, and locally developed courses such as Study Skills, Office Aide, and Teacher Aide.
