Reedy High School has set a high standard of excellence, and has an enrollment of 2,148 students in grades 9-12. Reedy is accredited by the Texas Education Agency and has earned a rating of Exemplary. Out of the class of 2025, ninety-four percent of the student body was college-bound (eighty-six percent planned to attend four-year schools and eight percent planned to attend two-year schools.)

Grading System
