## Middle School Academic Guide and Course Catalog

## Algebra I Enrollment

To enroll in Algebra I Advanced, a student must either:

- Successfully complete Math 7 Advanced. Students will also take an Algebra readiness test in the spring which will assist in determining if a student is ready to take Algebra I Advanced.
- Complete Math 7 and score an 80% or higher on the 8th grade math Exam for Acceleration. Students will also take an Algebra readiness test in the spring which will assist in determining if a student is ready to take Algebra I Advanced.

## Advanced & On-Level High School Credit Courses/Advanced Middle School Courses

Students are encouraged to challenge themselves by taking a variety of advanced and/or high-school courses. However, students may level-down from advanced courses or drop high school courses during the **6th week** of school. This option is available as an option for students who are experiencing severe academic struggles and should only be utilized to prevent unnecessary failing grades, especially in high school credit courses. More information can be found in the FISD Middle School Academic Guide and Course Catalog. **Campus administration has authority and final approval on all necessary schedule changes.**

## Instruction to Support Future Academic Success (all grade levels)

Students identified as needing additional math and/or reading instruction will be placed into a math and/or reading lab class. This class will take the place of an elective class. The purpose of this course is to support individualized student needs in the foundational area of mathematical and reading skills. Texas Administrative Code requires remediation for any student who fails to demonstrate satisfactory performance on the state assessments.

## New Students

Students transferring from another Texas school must provide STAAR results from the most recent administration. If STAAR results are not available immediately, please note that necessary schedule changes will be made to address any academic needs once they are received. If a student enrolls from out of state, private school, or home school, the student will complete diagnostic assessments to determine math and reading skill levels.

## Schedule Changes

Students need to make course selections carefully during the course selection process as changes after school starts will be limited. Schedule change requests are subject to availability. A schedule change request does not guarantee that a schedule change will occur. All schedule changes must be approved by the principal or principal's designee.

## Elective Course Selection

While every effort will be made to schedule students into the elective courses of their choosing, students are not guaranteed enrollment in elective courses. Enrollment numbers and master scheduling conflicts can result in a student having to be registered for an alternative elective choice.
