Facilities, Planning and Demographics

– Richard Wilkinson, Assistant Superintendent for Facilities and Finance, presented an update on current projects and plans for future schools in Frisco ISD. The list of schools include: Heritage High School, Lone Star High School, Lamar and Norma Hunt Middle School, Libby Maus Middle School, Robert Cobb Middle School, Gerald Sonntag Elementary School, George and Debra Purefoy Elementary School, Allen Elementary and the Early Childhood Center.

Staffing

Dr. Linda Bass, Assistant Superintendent for Human Resources, presented on the three main areas of the Human Resources Department.

Administrative Support: Oversee local, state and federal reports. It also handles district staffing, the compensation schedule, policies and procedures, employee contracts, due processes, grievances and hearings.

Professional Support: Oversee principal and teacher resources, such as recruiting and retention and campus staffing. They also handle hiring, employee transfer process, employee recognition, PDAS, the GOAL program, and the master's degree tuition reimbursement program.

Auxiliary Support: Oversees principal, supervisor, and staff resources. Hiring, substitute teachers, employee leaves and absences, the employee sick leave bank, auxiliary job descriptions and evaluations. They also oversee FLSA compliance, SB 9 compliance (fingerprinting), and employee badges.

Mr. Kenny Chandler ended the meeting with a short presentation on the visit to Galena Park and how Gifted and Talented students are identified in our district.
