

Fifth Grade Mathematics Advancement Testing Information for Parents

Requirements

To advance to the next round of testing (7th grade mathematics), a student must get at least 90% of the test items correct on the 6th grade mathematics CBE (Credit By Exam).

Scenarios and Recommended Coursework

Student passes 6th grade but not 7th grade CBE – take 6th grade PreAP Mathematics Course
Student passes 6th and 7th grade CBEs – take 7th grade PreAP Mathematics Course

About the Tests

The criterion referenced tests used for mathematics advancement are from the University of Texas. The turn around on score reports is timely and the elementary counselor will notify the parent of the results before the last day of school.

Where will students test and when?

For the 6th grade mathematics CBE, the student will test at their elementary home campus in May, after April TAKS testing is over. See the information below for specific details about testing from your child's elementary counselor.

If the passing requirement is met, the middle school will administer the 7th grade mathematics CBE. The elementary counselor will contact the middle school counselor and inform them if the requirement was met. The 7th grade CBE will take place in August/September at the middle school, arranged by the middle school counselor, who will contact parents for those arrangements.
