On Wednesday August 11, both *first-year teachers* and teachers *new to Frisco ISD* will spend the day becoming familiar with FISD Formative Assessments and Quality Questioning, visiting a Model Classroom, and/or learning more about Diverse Learners at Liberty High School from 8:00-3:30. *All new teachers and support staff should report to Liberty High School by 8:00. Lunch is on your own from 11:00-12:30.* ***Professional development will pre-register all first-year and new to Frisco ISD teachers.***

year teachers and teachers *new to Frisco ISD* will spend the day experiencing job-specific professional development from 8:00-3:30 at Liberty High School. *All new teachers and support staff should report to Liberty High School by 8:00. Lunch is on your own from 11:00-12:30.* ***Eduphoria Registration is now open.***

On Friday, August 13, both *first-year teachers* and teachers *new to Frisco ISD* will receive a hearty district welcome at the New Teacher Breakfast sponsored by Frisco ISD and the Frisco Chamber of Commerce at Heritage High School from 7:30-10:30. The morning will conclude in the auditorium with a keynote address from Steve Knagg and many, many fabulous door prizes. *All new teachers and support staff should arrive by 7:30 AM and will report to their home campus for an afternoon of campus orientation immediately following the New Teacher Breakfast (approximately 10:30).* ***Eduphoria Registration is now open.***
