Gentlemen

- Required attire is a tux or suit.
- Dress shoes are required to be worn (no sandals, athletic shoes, high-tops, vans, slippers, or house shoes).
- No hats, shades, bandanas, grills, or other miscellaneous items that are a violation of the school dress code will be allowed.
- All school dress code policies will be enforced.

Young Ladies

- Expected attire include: Dresses and skirts that are within school dress code (must be finger-tip length; slits must extend past finger-tip length)
- Dress shoes are expected to be worn (no slippers, house shoes or athletic shoes).
- Dresses should be modestly cut; no plunging necklines are allowed.
- All dresses must cover the midriff region and be modest in style with no sheer fabric in the front of dress. This includes:
 - No two-piece, bra-top-type dresses.
 - No see through tops or bra-tops.
 - No “mesh” that attaches a bra top to a skirt bottom, thus making it a one-piece dress.
 - No “cut-outs” in the front of the dress.
- Backless dresses allowed and must be waistline or higher.
- Spaghetti straps and strapless dresses are acceptable as long as dress code regarding cleavage is observed.

HHS administration will not allow students into the dance if their attire does not comply with these standards and refunds will not be given.

As this is a school sponsored activity, ANY PERSON that attends the Heritage High School Prom MUST be in compliance with the HHS dress code and all Heritage High School Policies & Procedures.

HHS students are ultimately responsible for ensuring proper dress code attire of themselves and their dates.
