



GIFTED AND TALENTED DISTRICT REFERRAL AND SCREENING

GRADES 2 through 11

- Frisco ISD will take referrals for gifted and talented screening from **Friday, February 5th through Friday, February 19th**.
- Students **currently enrolled** in Frisco ISD in **grades 2 through 11** may be referred by parents, teachers, counselors, administrators or other community members for formal assessment. *Students who were assessed by the G/T program during the 08/09 school year are not eligible for further assessment at this time. Standardized test scores are considered valid for two years.
- The assessment in **PHASE I** consists of the Cognitive Abilities test, which will be administered on Saturday, March 6th. *Only students who receive a score of 130 or higher on any subtest, or receive an overall composite score of 128 or above will proceed with further screening.*
- The assessments in **PHASE II** include the Iowa Test of Basic Skills Achievement test, along with performance products for elementary students and core subject grades for secondary students.
- If you would like to refer your child for **PHASE I** assessment, please contact the Gifted and Talented Teacher on your child's campus to request a referral packet. The completed packet must be returned to the G/T Teacher no later than **4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 19th**.
- *Students already identified for the FISD Gifted program do not need to retest.
