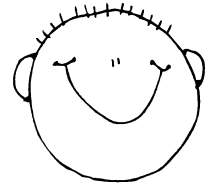

Handwriting: Qq, Ss

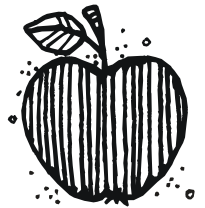
Writing: We will be learning the proper way to hold a pencil as well as good writing positions in our chairs.
