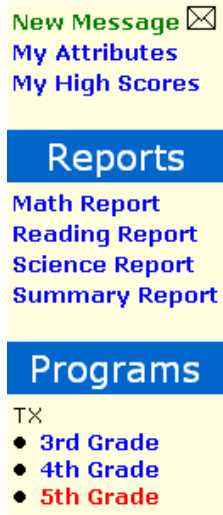


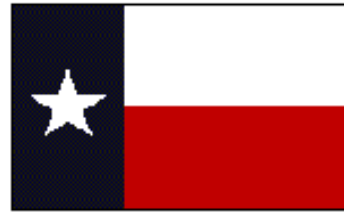
## To Access the Reports:

1. After your child has logged in, select a subject from the left-hand side of the screen to access the reports.



2. Here, you will find a variety of reports with information such as how much time your child has spent on various subjects, how they used their time, and what questions they missed.

You will also be able to compare your child with other children in their class and in their state that are using Study Island. You can select reports by Subject or select the Summary option to get all subjects.



## Texas Assessment of Knowledge & Skills Test Information

### What should you know about the TAKS Test?

- TAKS measures the statewide curriculum in reading and mathematics at grades 3 through 8 and the exit level; in writing in grades 4, 7, and the exit level; and in science in grades 5 and 10; and in social studies at grade 8.
- Spanish-version TAKS tests are administered at grades 3 through 6.
- Satisfactory performance on the TAKS exit level tests is prerequisite to a high school diploma.

# STUDY ISLAND

## Using Study Island from Home

The Study Island state assessment program is completely web-based. Therefore, students can access it from any computer with an Internet connection and a standard web browser (Internet Explorer or Netscape) at school or at home.

Results from students study sessions are recorded and made available to the teachers; this includes results from sessions completed at home.

The program is divided into sections based on subject (math, reading, etc.). Each section is made up of 10 to 25 topics, which contain about 20 to 25 questions each.

All topics are accompanied by a lesson with the exception of the pretests and post tests. The lesson includes some brief information about the material covered by the questions in the topics. **Your child needs to view the lesson before answering**

## Follow the instructions below, to use the program:

- Go to [www.studyisland.com](http://www.studyisland.com)
- Enter your username and password at the upper-left of the screen, and click "Login".

### NOTE

**Password:** birthdate (mmddyy)

Example: 012299

- Check to see if your teacher listed any assignments or notes.
- Select your grade level.
- Select the subject (math, reading, etc.)
- Select a topic.
- Click *Start Studying*
- Select **Test Mode** when doing this lesson for the first time. Once you earn a blue ribbon, you can do the lesson again in Game Mode.

- To pass a topic, you must satisfy your passing requirements which are based on a minimum number of items answered (usually 10) and a minimum percentage correct. A blue ribbon icon is displayed next to all passed topics. In this example, the minimum # of items for the topic is 10 and the minimum passing requirement is 76%.

Passing Goal
Items:Score
10 : 76%

- If you don't pass the topic, you will need to complete a remedial lesson that will appear under the original topic. Once you pass that lesson, you will receive a white ribbon and will be able to try once again for a blue ribbon for that topic.

**Note:** If your score is lower than the passing requirement, you may have to complete the lesson multiple times in order to bring your score up to passing so please take your time and don't guess.

- When you pass all topics in all sections, you have completed the program and will be well prepared to take the state test.
