Teacher of the Year Guidelines

1. To be considered, a teacher must be a full-time, state certified teacher, grades K-12.
2. A teacher's principal or superintendent is the only person who can actually nominate a teacher.
3. The first Teacher of the Month will be chosen in September. One teacher will be named each month thereafter through May.
4. Nominations can be mailed, faxed or emailed anytime during the school year.
5. Each Teacher of the Month will receive \$500 and a plaque. They will also be interviewed live with Johnny B and Carrie on the 97.5 KLAK Morning Show.
6. The Teacher of the Year will receive an additional \$500, another plaque and an all inclusive trip for two.
7. Each Teacher of the Month will be honored with a banquet at the end of the school year, which is attended by area school principals, superintendents and honorees.
8. Once a nomination is received it will remain in the drawing until selected by a judge or until the program ends in May. Each September the program will start over with all new nominations.
