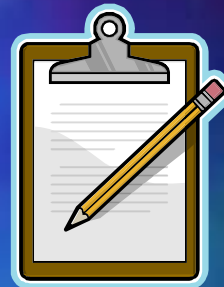

Recommended PreAP Entrance Criteria



Students who meet the criteria below are encouraged to register for Pre-AP classes.

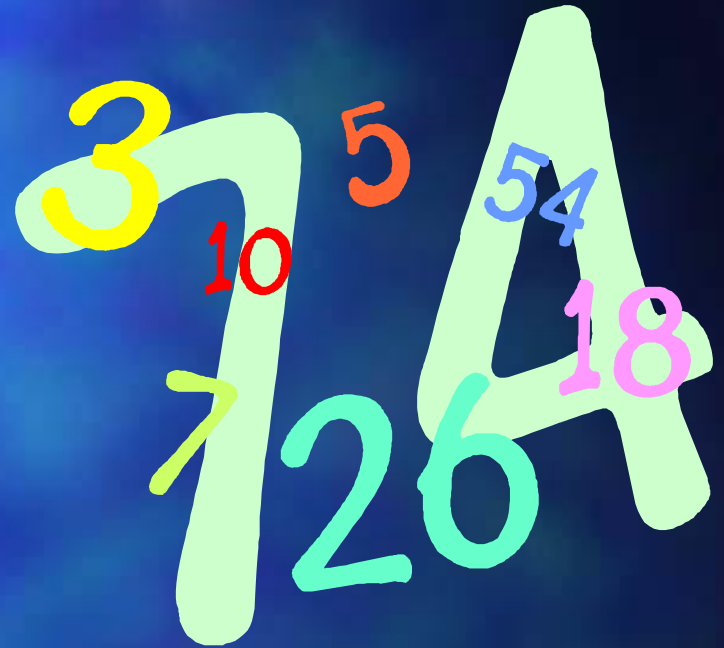
- **90% on TAKS (previous school year)**
- **Cumulative classroom average of 90 or higher in the area of interest (current school year)**
- **Willing to work hard, complete all assignments on time, and are conscientious students.**

Pre AP Maintenance Criteria (for all grade levels):

- ✓ *A student who earns below an 80 in a six weeks grading period will be placed on academic probation.*
- ✓ *If an average of below 80 is earned for two consecutive six weeks, the student will be placed into the corresponding regular level class.*

Middle School Math

- 6th grade
- 6th grade Pre-AP
- 7th grade
- 7th grade Pre-AP
- 8th grade
- **Algebra I** – Students receive high school credit, but the grade is not computed in high school GPA
- **Geometry** – Students receive high school credit, but the grade is not computed in high school GPA



Pre AP Math Courses in Middle School

- Students in 6th grade on-level math are expected to learn all of the 6th grade TEKS while students in 6th grade Pre AP math are expected to learn all of the 6th and all of the 7th grade TEKS.
- Students in 7th grade on-level math are expected to learn all of the 7th grade TEKS while students in 7th grade Pre AP math are expected to review some of the 7th grade TEKS and learn all of the 8th grade TEKS.
- Pre AP students are expected to complete more intense assignments on their own at home and to review their class notes each day in preparation for the next class.
- Pre AP classes accelerate students by one grade level in order to allow for access to AP Calculus in high school.
- If students take high school math classes in middle school, they are still required to take 3 math classes during their 9th-12th grade years.

Special Programs

■ English as a Second Language

- Please write "ESL" at the top of your registration card. An LPAC meeting will be held later this semester to discuss official placement. Student rosters and LPAC information will be sent directly from the elementary campus to FMS.

■ Gifted and Talented

- Please write "GT" at the top of your registration card to indicate that your child is currently in the FISD GT program. A roster of GT students will be sent directly from the elementary campuses to FMS. GT students are served through the English and Reading courses, so please write **English GT & Reading GT** on the registration card.

Special Programs

- **Special Education**

Please write "SpEd" at the top of your registration card to indicate that your child is currently receiving special education services. Student rosters and ARD information will be sent directly from the elementary campuses to FMS.

- **Dyslexia**

Please write "Dyslexia" at the top of your registration card to indicate that your child is currently in the dyslexia program. Official placement for your child will be determined later this semester at your home campus. Student rosters and their placements will be sent directly from the elementary campuses to FMS.

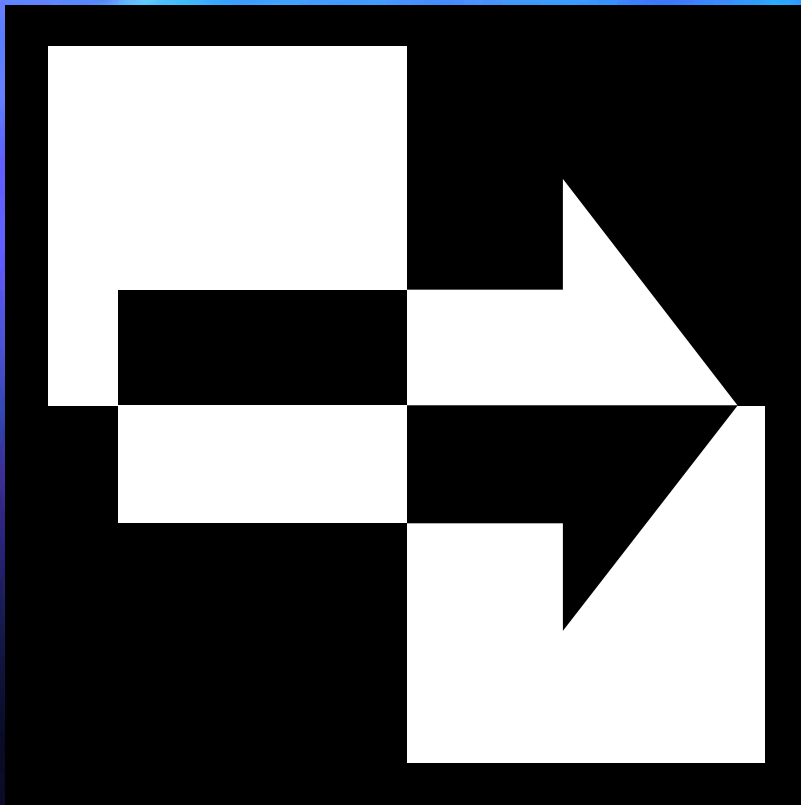
