

CTE Center Student Transportation Information

Your schedule indicates that you are enrolled in a class that meets at the CTE Center. The CTE Center is located at 9889 Wade Boulevard. Please find important information listed below.

CTE Center Bell Schedule

This is the time your class meets at the CTE Center. If you are driving to the CTE Center, you will need to know this. Late arrivals will be counted tardy.

1st Period: 8:45-10:15
2nd Period: 10:45-12:00
3rd Period: 12:55-2:25
4th Period: 2:55-4:25

CTE Center Bus Schedule

This is the time the bus leaves your home campus for the CTE Center. The bus will leave promptly at the time listed below. If you are riding the bus to the CTE Center for 1st period the bus will be leaving from the back of LHS. 2nd, 3rd and 4th period the bus will leave from the front of LHS. Missing the bus will be counted as a tardy.

1st Period: * Bus leaves at 7:40, please be at school no later than 7:30

2nd Period: Bus leaves at 10:35
3rd Period: Bus leaves at 12:45
4th Period: Bus leaves at 2:45

You will ride the bus from the CTE Center back to your home campus in time for your next class.

*If you have a **1st period** CTE Center class you may also ride the CTE Shuttle bus from a designated stop indicated by the Bus Route Route/Infofinder located on the Transportation page on the Frisco ISD Website. You may also provide your own transportation to the CTE Center for 1st period. Please note that regular neighborhood buses will not get you to LHS in time to catch the CTE Center Shuttle Bus.

If you have a **3rd period** CTE Center classes, you will eat "A" LUNCH at your home campus, then catch the bus promptly at 12:45.

If you have a double-blocked 2nd & 3rd period CTE Center class, you will eat "D" Lunch when you return from the CTE Center at 1:45.

If you have a **4th period** CTE Center class you may ride the CTE Shuttle Bus from the CTE Center to LHS or to a designated stop indicated by the Bus Route/Infofinder located on the Transportation page on the Frisco ISD website. You may also provide your own transportation from the CTE Center after 4th period.

If you are driving, you will need a CTE Center parking pass. You will need to bring a copy of your driver's license and a copy of your insurance information. CTE Center ID badges must be worn at all times when you on the CTE Center campus.
