### ***Orchestra Students Receive Honors***

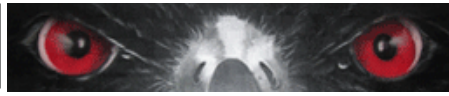

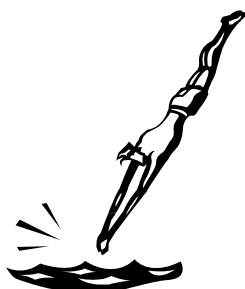
