September 13: @ Lone Star HS	Bullying and Student Learning <i>When there is bullying in the learning environment, it affects everyone. Parents need to know what to do if their child is being bullied, what are the characteristics of those who bully, and what role does Frisco ISD play in addressing this behavior.</i>
October 4: @ Liberty HS	Substance Abuse and Student Development <i>Alcohol and drug abuse is dangerous for many reasons. These reason could be that it tends to stunt normal development, can cause a vitamin deficiency, cognitive deficits, coordination problems, and damage to memory.</i>

Every preteen, teen, and college student needs information and skills for forming healthy relationships and reducing the likelihood of dating violence and sexual harassment.
