



GIFTED AND TALENTED DISTRICT SCREENING

GRADES 2ND through 11TH

- Frisco ISD will begin taking referrals for the Gifted and Talented program from Friday, February 5th through Friday, February 19th.
- Students currently enrolled in Frisco ISD in grades 2nd-11th may be nominated by parents, teachers, counselors, administrators or other community members for formal screening. *Students who were tested by the GT program during the 08/09 school year are not eligible for further screening at this time. Standardized test scores are considered valid for two years.
- PHASE I assessment consists of the Cognitive Abilities test, which will be administered on Saturday, March 6th. Only students who receive a score of 130 or higher on any subtest, or receive an overall composite score of 128 or above will be eligible for further screening.
- The PHASE II assessment process includes the Iowa Test of Basic Skills Achievement test, as well as performance products for elementary students and core subject grades for secondary students.
- If you would like to refer your child for PHASE I screening, please contact the Gifted and Talented Teacher on your child's campus to request a nomination packet. The completed packet must be returned to the GT Teacher no later than 4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 19th.

*Students already identified for the FISD Gifted program do not need to retest.
