Academic Pentathlon

The Academic Pentathlon was founded as a means of fostering scholastic excellence among students who represent a wide diversity of personal and academic backgrounds and interests. Separate competitions are held for seventh and eighth graders. Students compete as individuals and as teams in a series of five academic tests. These are: Seventh and Eighth Grade - Math, Science, Social Studies, Language Arts (essay) and Super Quiz. A team consists of nine competitors and 2 or 3 alternates. Each team must include three Honor, three Scholastic and three Varsity students as indicated in the following divisions: Honor: 3.75-4.00 GPA, Scholastic: 3.00-3.74 GPA, Varsity: 2.00-2.99 GPA
