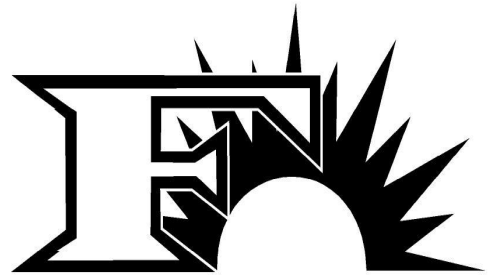

Dear Roach, Scoggins, Fowler, 9th Grade Liberty High and 9th grade Wakeland High (living in Panther Creek, Dominion, Latera and Creekside) Parents:

On Monday, October 13, the FISD Board of Trustees reviewed the proposed attendance zone for the new Heritage High School, which will open in the fall of 2009 with 9th and 10th graders and will relieve Liberty High.

Below is a map of this proposed zone. This preferred plan shows the Roach Middle School zone and part of the Scoggins Middle School zone feeding Heritage High. Fowler Middle School and part of Scoggins Middle School will continue to feed Liberty High School. This proposed plan allows for balanced enrollment between the high schools for several years and will allow Heritage High to be a 3A high school for its first two years as was Liberty and Wakeland. Lone Star High School located at Teel and Panther Creek Parkway is scheduled to open in 2010 with 9th-11th graders to relieve Wakeland High School.
