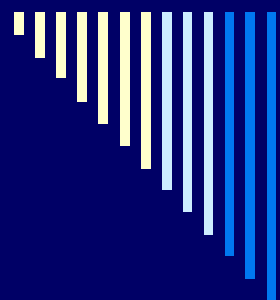

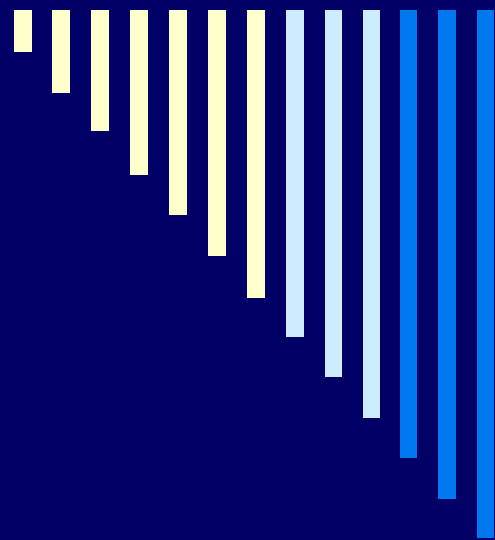

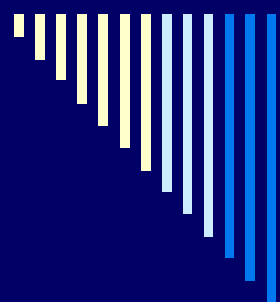

Try Outs

- Tryouts will begin Monday November 9 and end on Friday November 13, 2009 from 4:00-5:30p.m.
 - Any one can try out.
 - If someone who is not already in athletics tries out and makes the team, they will need to have their schedule changed to athletics.
 - Will keep 36 players (12, 12, 12 for A,B, and C) for each grade.

Try Outs Continued

- ❑ Everyone needs to have a physical in order to try out if they do not already have one on file.
- ❑ Players will be evaluated based on their skills, attitude, and knowledge level of the game of basketball.
- ❑ Any athlete who does not make the team is encouraged to seek out the Coaches to find out why.



Team Policies

Practices will begin promptly at 4:00p.m. and end at 5:30p.m. during the season.

Players need to be dressed and in the gym by 4:00p.m.

- Every player needs to have the proper equipment and clothes for practice. (basketball shoes, practice gear provided by the school)
- There will be consequences based on the coaches discretion for not following team rules and policies. (see athletic policies)
- Tutorials:
 - best if done before school, afternoon's are alright if necessary.
 - Athletes need a note from their teachers or parents in order to go to tutorials in the afternoon.
 - Athletes must notify the coach prior practice.



Athletic Injury Treatment Procedure for Scoggins Middle School

- ❑ Injury Occurs at a school sanctioned athletic event.
 - ❑ Coaches evaluate and administer first aid.
 - ❑ Minor injuries are evaluated and treated by coaches/school nurse.
 - ❑ Major injuries are sent to be evaluated and treated by the athletic trainers at Liberty High School.
 - ❑ Major injuries requiring further expertise to evaluate and treat are referred to our Team Doctor by the attending athletic trainer.
 - ❑ *NOTE: Any injury that occurs outside of a school sanctioned athletic event is not eligible for participation in this procedure.*

- ❑ Attendance is mandatory; skipping is not allowed
 - ❑ Practice will take place after school

Attendance Continued

- Injuries-
 - Parent note stating reason needed to be excused from workout
 - If an athlete is unable to work out for more than 2 days in a row, a doctor's note will be required.
 - Trainer- Joseph White, Liberty HS
 - If Coaches deem injury serious we will send athlete to be seen by the trainer
 - He is trained to treat athletic injuries

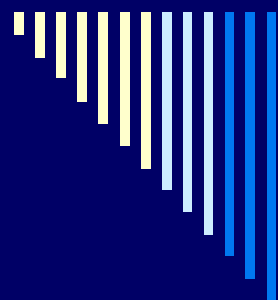
Game Day Policies and Procedures

- ❑ Athletes will not be allowed to participate in game activities if they have failed a class for the previous six weeks and are not passing every class by the time progress reports comes around.
 - ❑ First game starts at 5:45 and the next game will start 10 minutes after previous game.
 - ❑ 7th & 8th Grade Girls play at the same location except for the Frisco Tournament.

Game Day Policies Continued

- ❑ Athletes will be allowed to work on homework before and after the games.
 - ❑ Athletes must ride bus to games and ride home on the bus, unless **signed** out by parents. Special (i.e. emergency) circumstances need Athletic Coordinator approval).
 - ❑ Attendance- be at school on game day
Special circumstances (i.e. funeral, religious ceremony, etc.) need to be brought to the attention of the Athletic Coordinator before the absence occurs.
 - ❑ Dress- Dress for Success: dresses, dress pants/shirt, comfortable shoes!!!
 - ❑ *Look, Act, Play* Professionally
 - ❑ Trouble acquiring items- see Athletic Coordinator privately

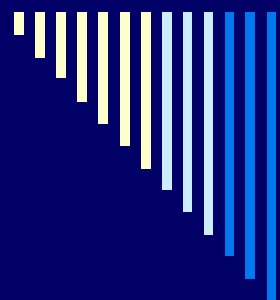
