

Parents:

During the 2008-2009 school year several schools in Frisco ISD completed a pilot program with the Raptor Technology Visitor Registration System. After this trial, FISD has decided to begin using it district-wide. All of you are already familiar with check-in procedures for school visitors and that process will still occur. **The biggest difference is that the initial time you (or any visitor) come to the school and need to enter beyond the double door entry you will need to provide your driver's license to be scanned.** After that, you need to show your ID to check out your child. As always, the only people who will be allowed to check out students or eat lunch on campus are parents or other adults who are on the emergency contact sheet.

Scanning your license enables the Raptor Technology System to check the national database for registered sex offenders. As you know, a parent may be a registered sex offender, but still be able to attend school functions according to the parameters of their court orders. School staff members are always in close proximity as these visits occur. Across the country this tool has allowed predators to be caught as they were trying to enter schools as vendors, repairmen, etc. If someone is identified as a sex offender, several parties are immediately notified and the information is verified quickly so that the campus can handle the situation appropriately. We continue to look for ways to assist us in keeping our students safe and we feel this is one more layer in that effort.

All parent and volunteer will still need to obtain the annual background check as usual. Here is the link:
