



Dear Frisco Students and Parents,

Each course will be limited to a minimum of 6 students, and a maximum of 20 students to ensure personal attention. The Comprehensive SAT course (usually \$999), our Essentials SAT course (usually \$699), and our SAT or ACT Boot Camp (usually \$150) allow Frisco students the convenience of taking the class on campus with a deep discount – making the total course tuition for Comprehensive \$600, for Essentials \$400, and Boot Camp \$125.
