Dear Parent or Guardian:

Frisco Independent School District will be continuing a drug, alcohol and/or steroid testing program that began in the 2000-2001 school year. This program is mandatory for all students who wish to participate in athletics. Students who are not involved in athletics may also participate in this drug testing program on a voluntary basis at the request of the parent or guardian. The procedures for voluntary students will be the same as for those students participating in athletics.

The action by the Board of Trustees to implement a substance abuse policy is an effort to provide an additional tool for all athletes to be drug free. It is the opinion of the Board of Trustees that it is the district's responsibility to ensure, to the extent possible, that participants in athletics are drug and/or alcohol free.

This program is designed as a substance prevention program. It is our hope and intent to encourage students to choose not to use drugs or alcohol and to provide those who use, a reason to stop.

The support of the parents and our community is vital to the success of this program and helping those students in need is our primary concern.
