



# Frisco ISD Cheerleading

Frisco ISD cheerleading tryouts are held each spring for both middle school and high school students. Access Frisco students who are interested in trying out for cheerleading for the 2026-27 school year need to apply in the first priority period, January 12-23, 2026. All Access Frisco students who are interested in trying out for cheerleader for the 2026-27 school year should follow the process listed below. Please read all information carefully to ensure eligibility and participation.

January 12, 2026	<b>Access Frisco Application Opens</b> *Students who are interested in trying out for cheerleader for the 2026-27 school year should fill out the Access Frisco application as soon as it opens.
January 23, 2026	Access Frisco application closes for the 1st round of the lottery.
January 26, 2026	Access Frisco applicants will begin receiving notifications if they have been offered a spot.
January 20 - February 12, 2026	High School Mandatory Tryout Meeting Window <a href="#">High School Tryout Meetings-(Access Frisco Campuses ONLY)</a>
February 9 - 27, 2026	Middle School Mandatory Tryout Meeting Window <a href="#">Middle School Tryout Meetings-(Access Frisco Campuses ONLY)</a>
February 20, 2026	Deadline for high school Access Frisco students who have an approved application to meet with the cheer coach to be eligible to try out for cheer.
February 27, 2026	Deadline for middle school Access Frisco students who have an approved application to meet with the cheer coach to be eligible to try out for cheer.

February 26, 2026	ALL high school cheer tryout packets must be turned in no later than 4:30pm.
March 6, 2026	ALL middle school cheer tryout packets must be turned in no later than 3:45pm.
March 10 - 13, 2026	High School Tryouts <a href="#">High School Tryout Schedule</a>
March 27 - April 1, 2026	Middle School Tryouts <a href="#">Middle School Tryout Schedule</a>

1. Once a student is offered a seat at a high school or middle school campus, it should be accepted immediately. Acceptance begins the official approval process, which may take up to three weeks, and must be fully completed, including issuance of a Frisco ISD student ID number, before a student is eligible for cheer tryouts. Students without a completed approval and a student ID will not be allowed to try out.
2. Access Frisco students offered a seat after their campus's mandatory tryout meeting, or who missed the tryout meeting, must have a parent/guardian contact the cheer coach to arrange an alternate way to receive the meeting information. The deadline for Access Frisco parents to meet with the coach and obtain a tryout packet is **February 20** for high school campuses and **February 27** for middle school campuses.
3. Access Frisco students trying out for cheerleader will be required to meet all deadlines for tryout eligibility.
