Responses: *2,672 (nearly 60% of teachers)*

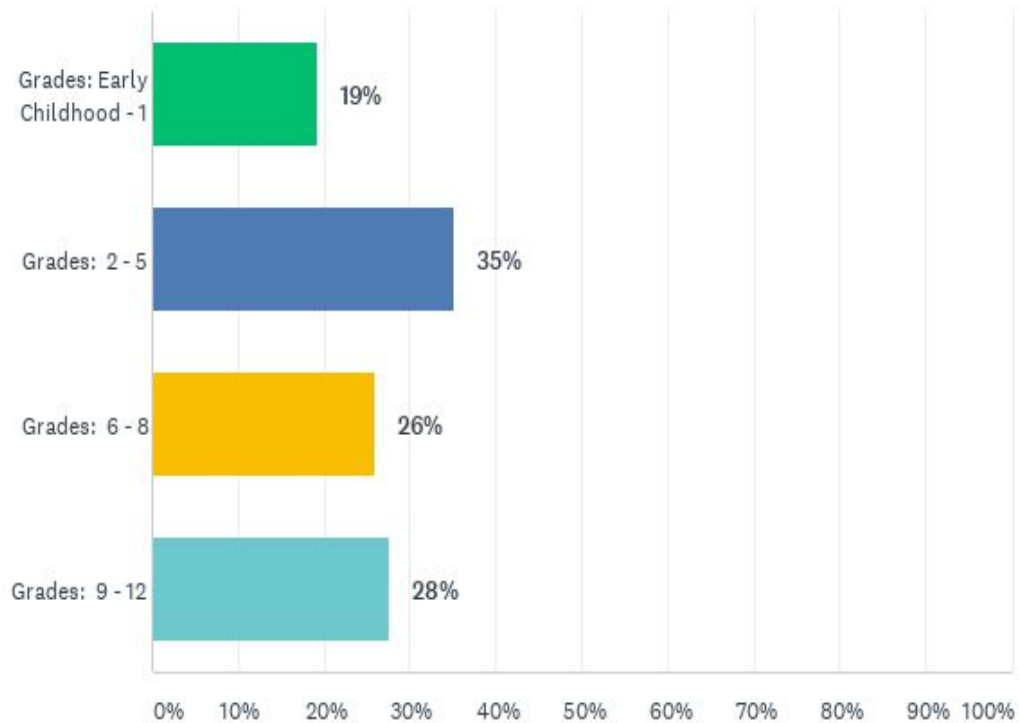

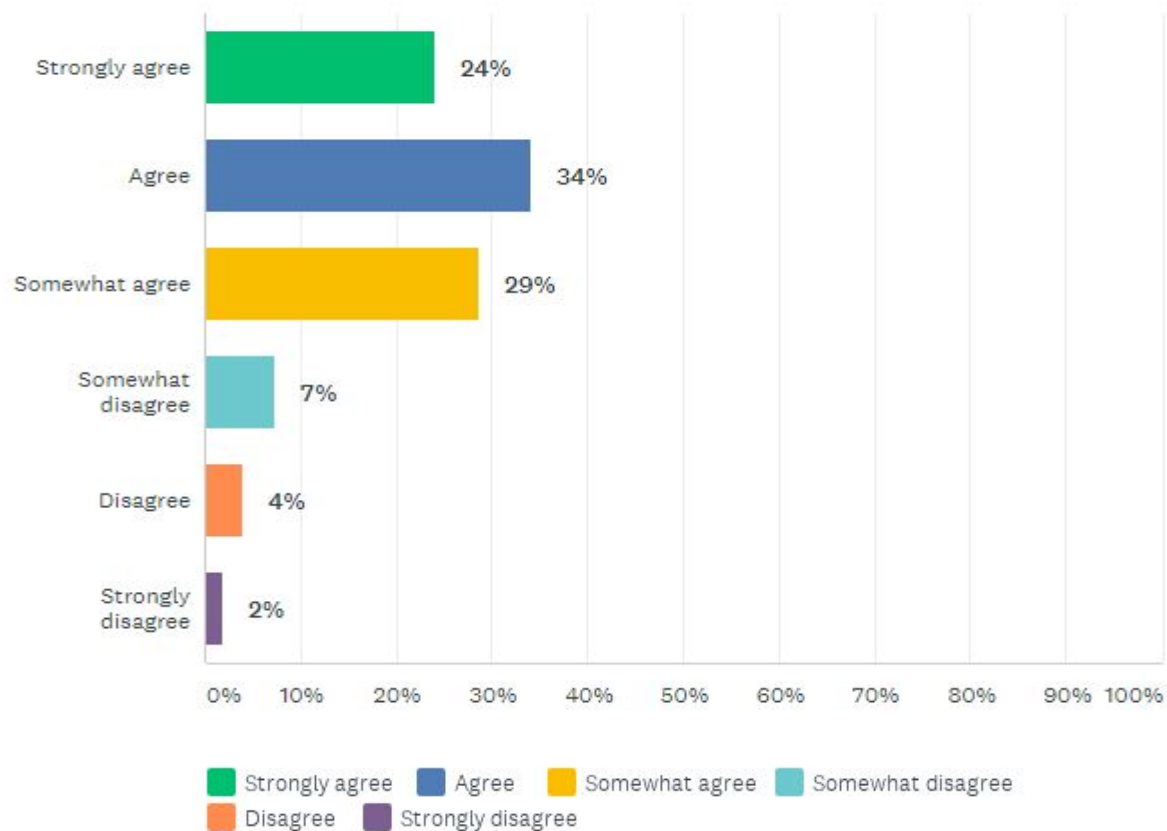

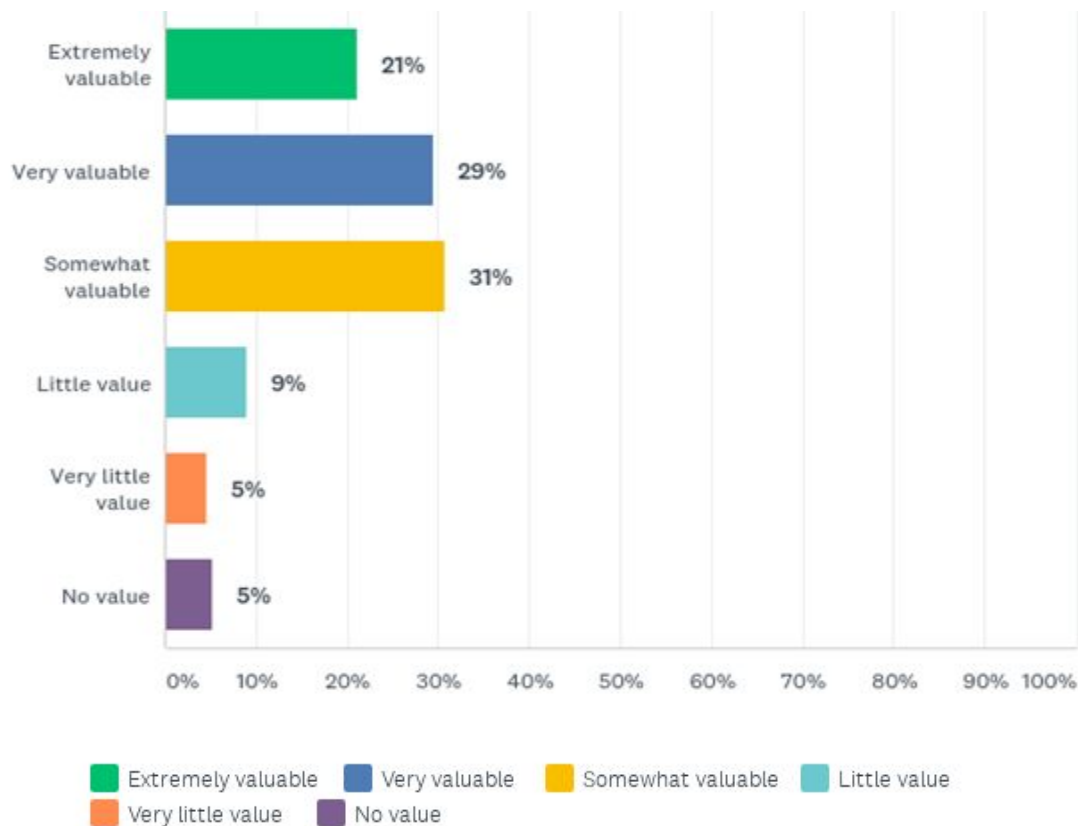

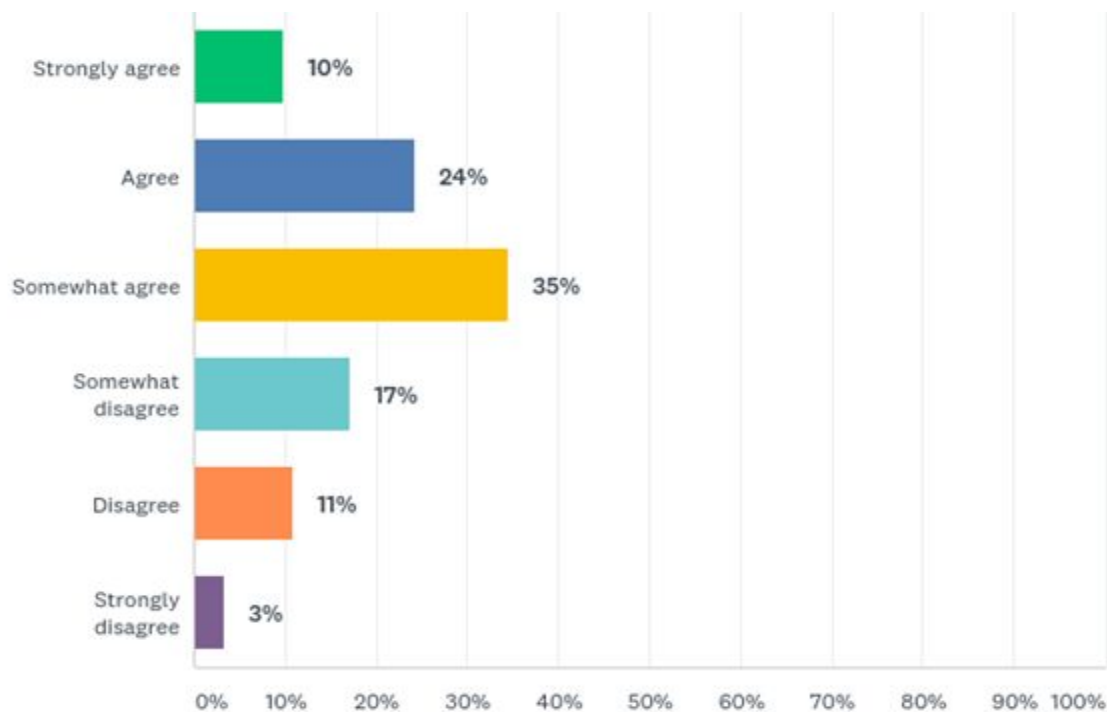
Q4 The design of my at-home workspace allowed me to be productive and meet student needs.



Q5 The FISD scope and sequence documents were a valuable support to my instructional planning during eLearning.

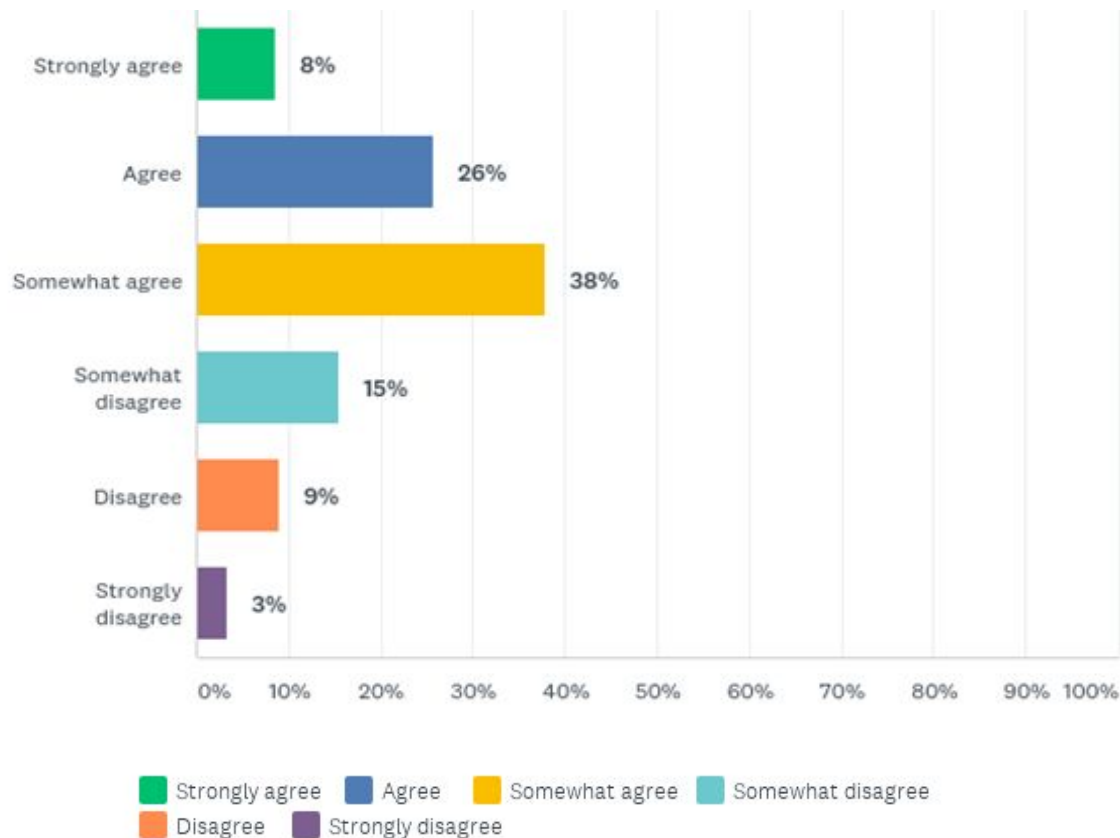

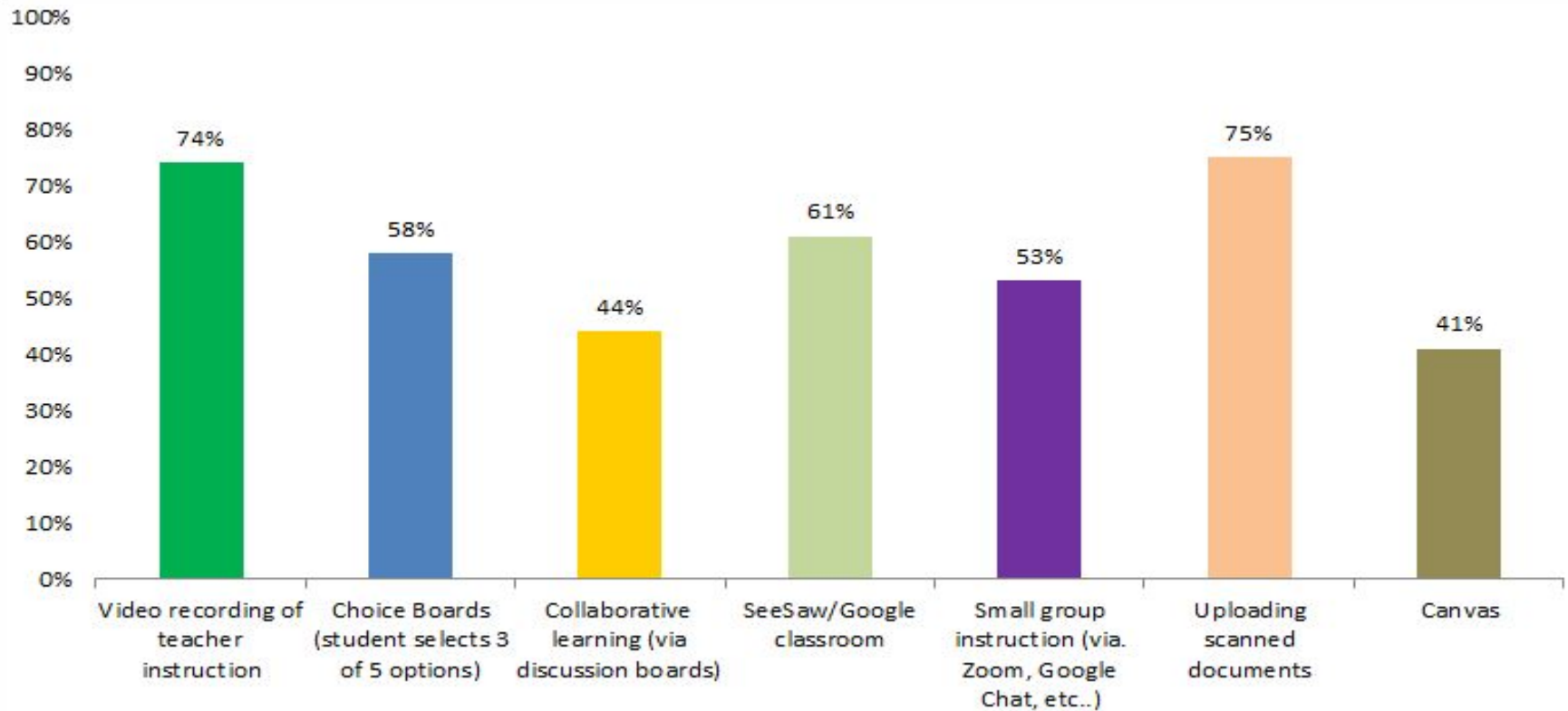

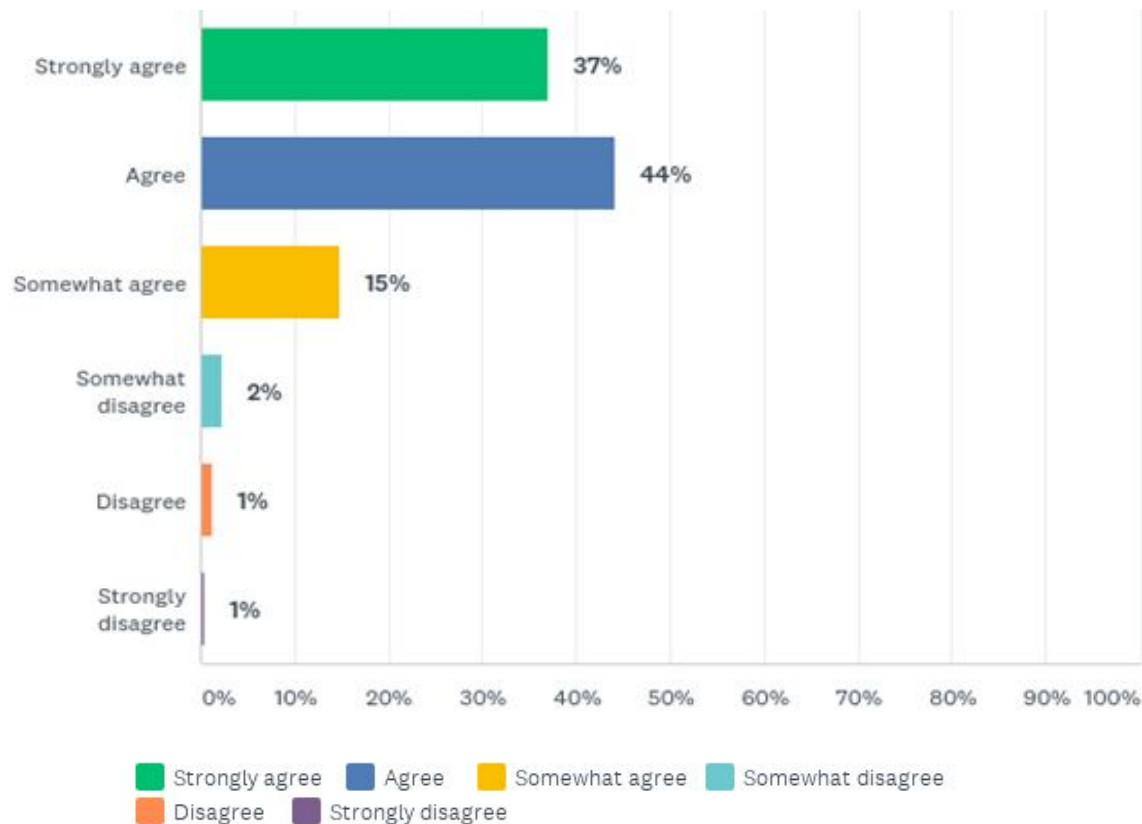
Q8 Identify the primary modes of instruction you utilized during eLearning



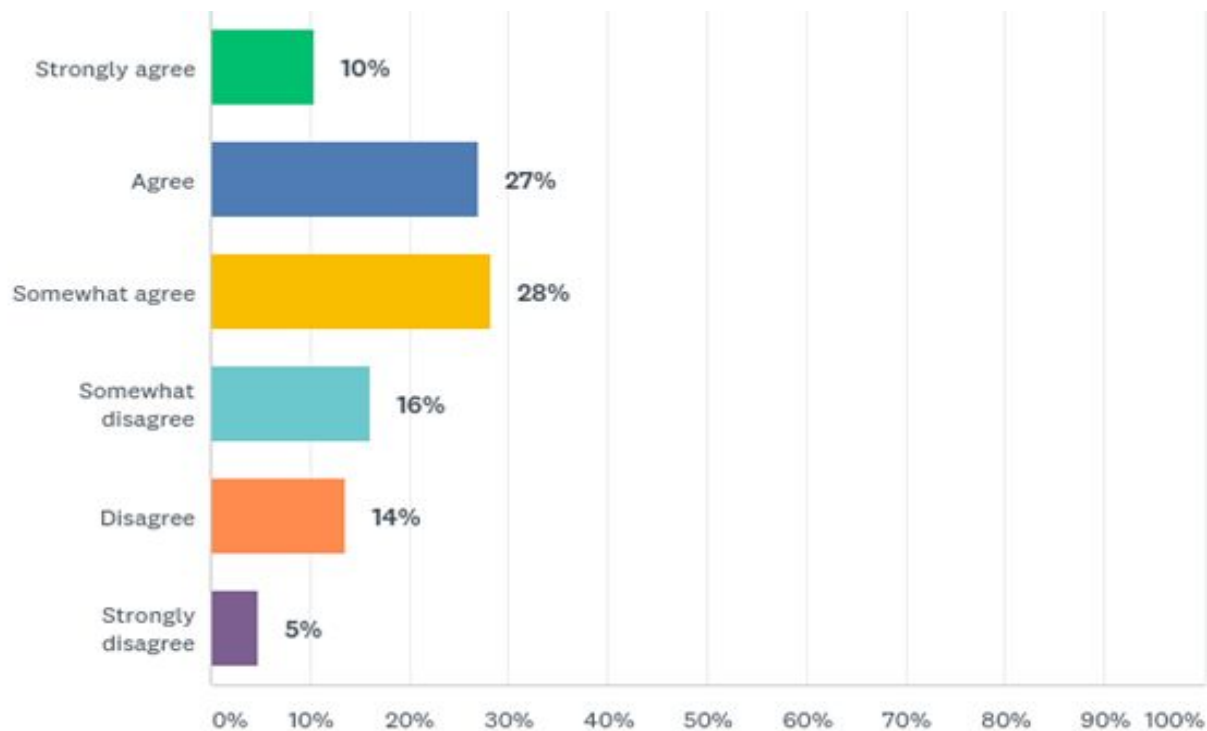
Q9 I was able to meet the requirements and provide necessary supports for students with specialized learning plans (e.g., IEP; 504; GT).



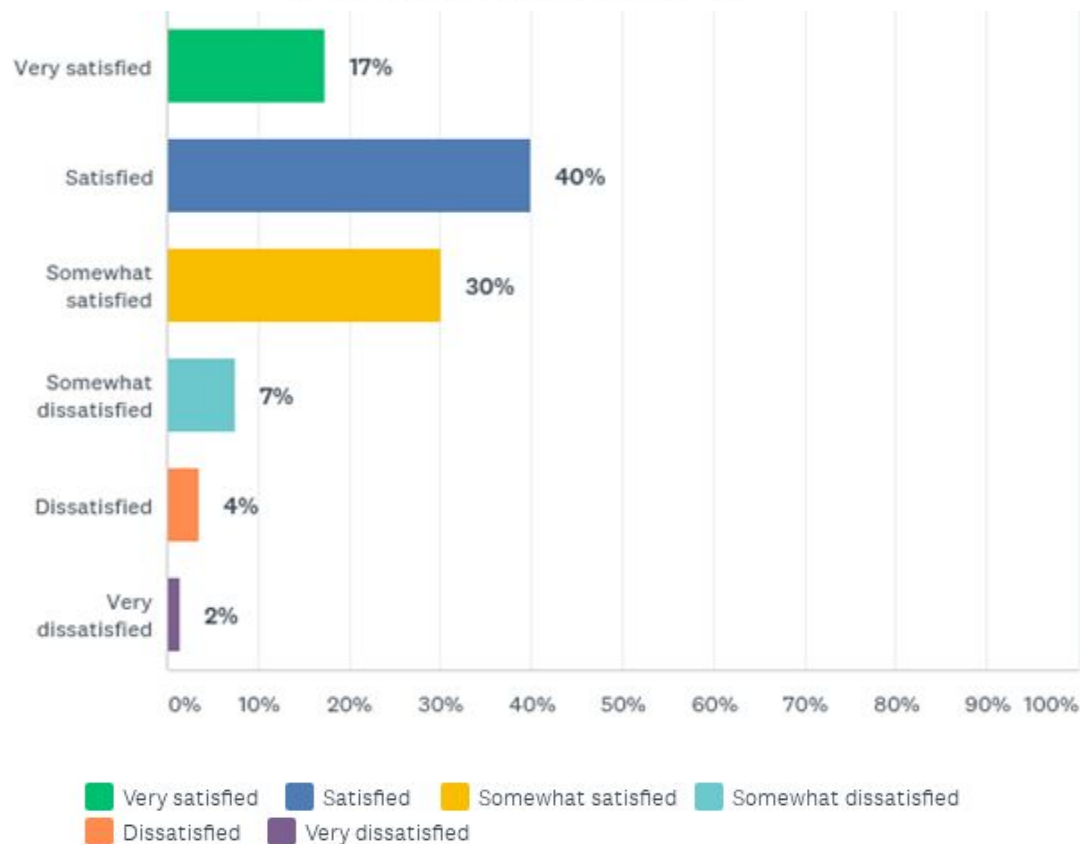
Q10 I was able to keep track of assignment submission and provide feedback to students on their learning.



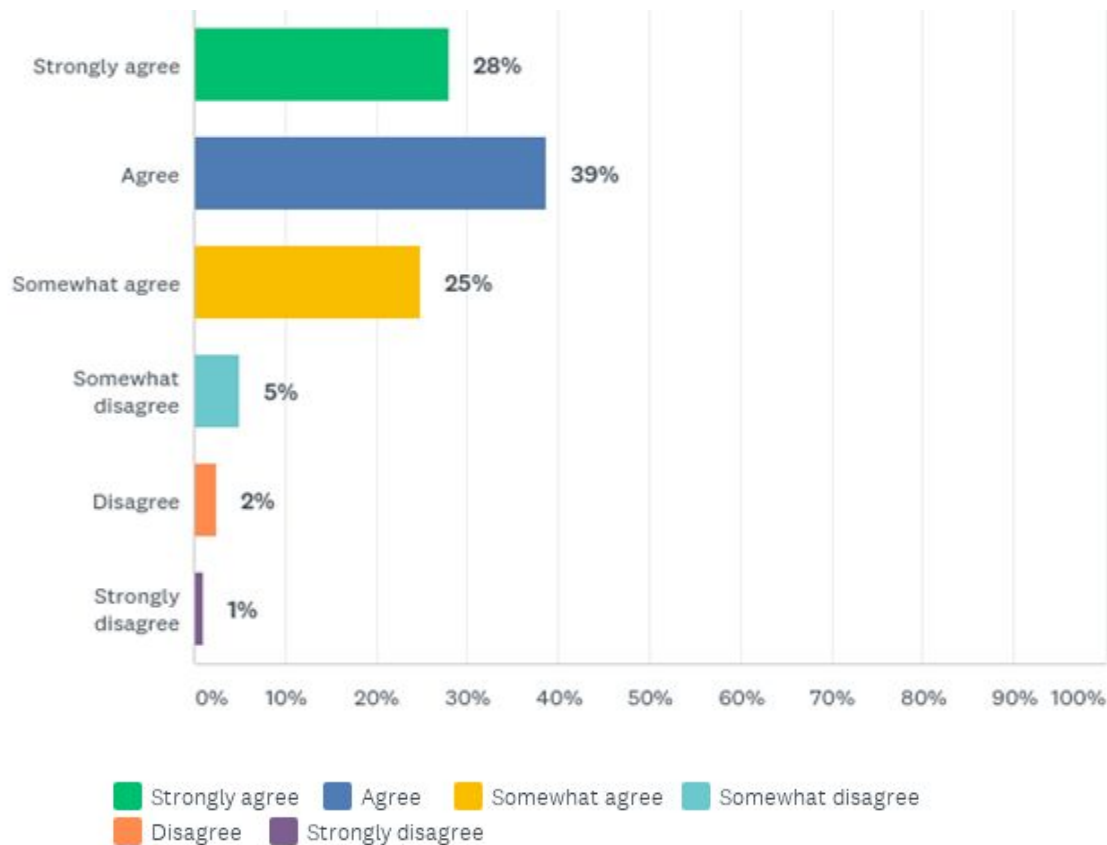
Q11 I was able to utilize formative assessments to inform my instructional practice.



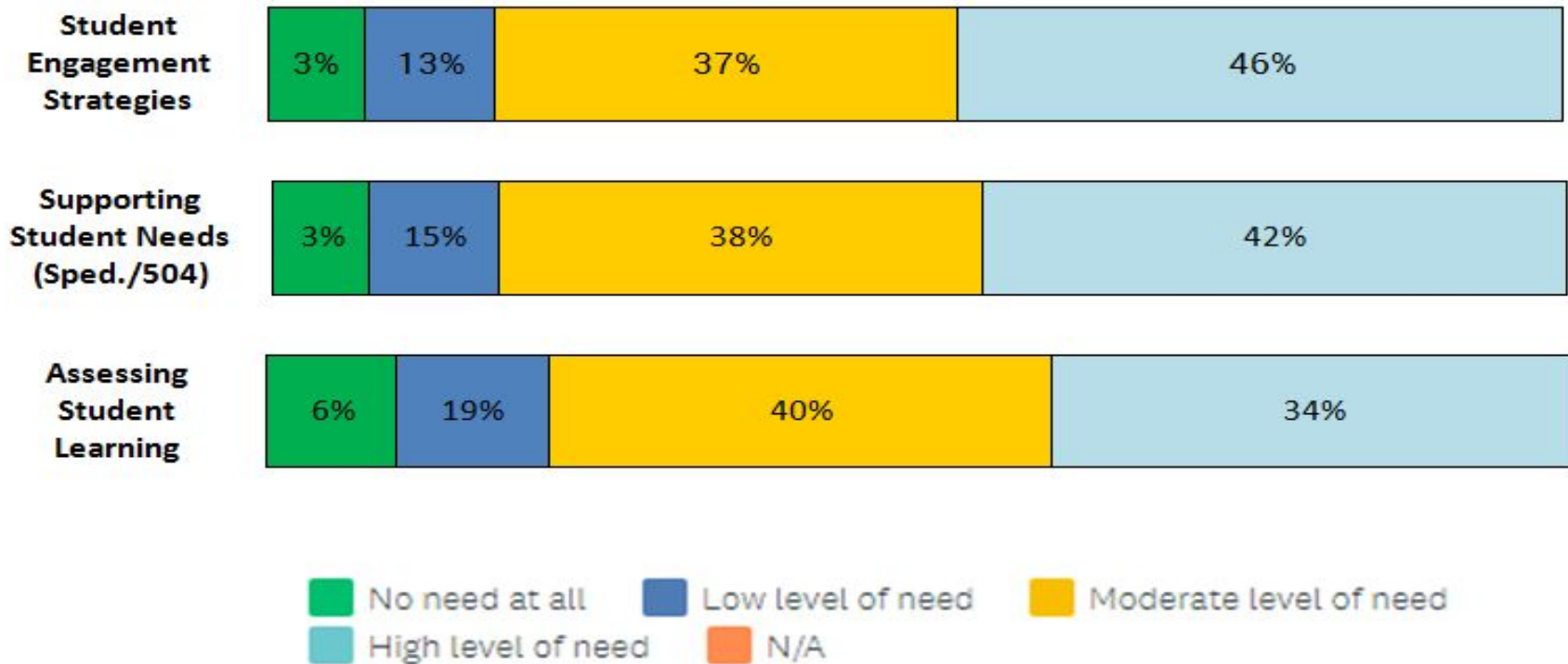
