Review Past examples of SHAC work

- Counseling & Psychological Services/Social & Emotional Climate
 - Adopt and implement a policy addressing sexual abuse and other maltreatment of children (anti-vicitmization program)
 - Develop training for staff members on Human Trafficking, Child Abuse and Neglect
 - Provided child abuse hotlines and posters to each campus
 - Develop a library of videos for websites and PSA's
 - Hosted parent presentations
- Health and Physical Education, Nutrition, Physical Environment
 - o Reviewed and updated the Wellness Plan
 - Received board approval of the updated Wellness Plan
 - Created the triennial assessment tool for approval by the SHAC
 - Send triennial assessment tool to all campus locations to assess baseline implementation of the FISD Wellness Policy and Plan
 - Provide best practice recommendations to campuses
- Family Engagement and Community Involvement
 - o FISD Health and Wellness Fair
 - Hosted Parent Presentations "<u>Pandemic Population</u>" in Jan '22 & <u>Chasing Childhood Screening</u> in April '22. Both offered opportunities to examine student behavior and mindsets and parenting practices post-pandemic.
- Health and Employee Wellness
 - Promoting a health topic every month (email to all employees) & encouraging employees to get an annual exam by a health care provider.
 - Breast Cancer Awareness Month
 - Men's Health Month
 - Heart Health Awareness
 - Flu Vaccine Clinics were offered at all campuses & districtwide sites for students, employees, & their families. Additional vaccines were also offered.
