Emerson High School has set a high standard of excellence, and has an enrollment of 1,853 students in grades 9-12. Emerson is accredited by Texas Education Agency. The first graduating class for Emerson was the class of 2024. Out of the class of 2025, eighty-nine percent of the student body was college-bound (seventy-three percent planned to attend four-year schools, sixteen percent planned to attend two-year schools.)

## COMMUNITY

Frisco ISD is a community located approximately 30 miles north of Dallas, Texas. The district serves students in Frisco, Plano, McKinney, and Little Elm. Frisco ISD currently serves over 62,000 students at 77 campuses and is the largest district in Texas to earn an A in the 2024-25 TEA accountability rankings.

## Grading System
