

ROADMAP TO WORKING WITH YOUR

SCHOOL SUPPORT SPECIALIST



Stop 1: Talk To Your School Counselor

If you are in need of support securing outside community resources (medical assistance, clothing, housing assistance, outside counseling, food, etc.) let your school counselor know that you would like to work with your School Support Specialist.



Stop 2: Your Counselor Makes A Referral

Each SSS supports multiple elementary, middle, and high schools, and divides their time between the schools. School counselors submit referrals for families to work with their SSS.



Stop 3: Your SSS Contacts You

Once a referral is received, your SSS gets to work! They will contact the school counselor regarding the cause of the referral, and then reach out to you to learn more about how they can support your student.



Stop 4: Working With Your SSS

Your SSS will continue to communicate and collaborate with you through the process of securing the resources your student needs to be successful.
